



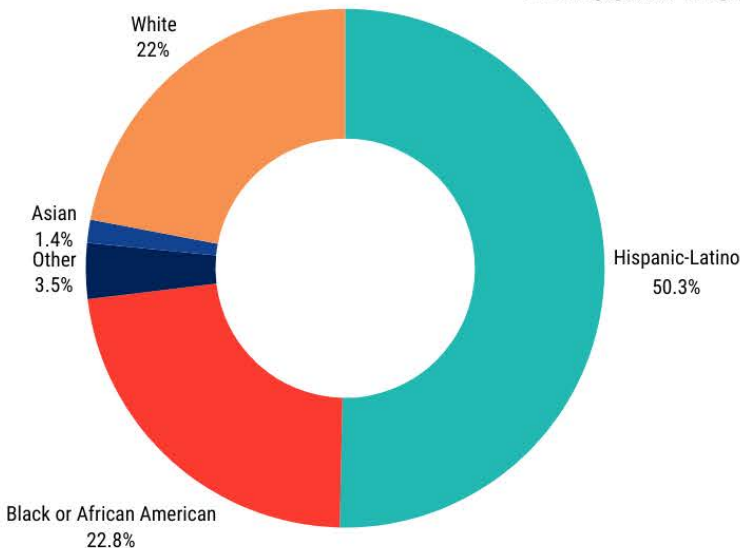
DISTRICT SNAPSHOT
