



EMPLOYEE LEAGUE RULES

PLAYERS RULES

1. Only BISD Employees will be allowed to participate in BISD Wellness Leagues. Student Teachers, part-time employees, substitutes, spouses or retired employees will not be allowed to participate.
2. Each player must have a signed release of liability and indemnification statement form turned in to the Wellness Department prior to participating. If form is not signed and turned in the team member cannot play.
3. Each School and /or Department can have more than one team.
4. Each player can only play on one team.
5. If team is disqualified, team members are not allowed to join another team during the season.
6. Team rosters must be turned in to the Wellness Coordinator before games begin. rosters need to be typed or print.
7. All players must be on a team roster one week prior to the game. Players can continue to be added until said deadline given by Wellness Coordinator.
8. Please remove all jewelry prior to the game. This is for safety issues.
9. Only tennis shoes and proper workout attire will be allowed on the gym floor. NO blue jeans permitted.
10. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. No fighting, taunting, tripping, pushing, scratching, profanity, or striking an opponent.
11. If any disagreements arise during a game, team captains should take the initiative to resolve the problem. If not possible, please discuss with the Wellness Coordinator Coordinator immediately.
12. If you receive a 2nd Warning, red card, technical foul or other misconduct notice from a referee or Wellness Coordinator, you will be immediately dismissed and not allowed to participate in any league for 2 years.

SPECTATOR RULES

13. Spectators will be allowed to watch the games and must remain seated at all times
14. Spectators cannot taunt, boo or physically get involved in any game situations.
15. Children may not be playing or running around the gym while the games are in play. This is to prevent accidents. Children are not allowed to bring outside balls or toys.
16. BISD Wellness Center is not liable for any injuries that might occur to unseated and unsupervised children, before, during or after league games.
17. BISD Wellness Coordinator reserves the right to dismiss any person who does not Comply with spectator rules and will not be allowed to enter the wellness gym indefinitely.
