LEVEL 4 INCIDENT - OFFICE DISCIPLINARY REFERRAL (ODR)

Student is escorted to office. Administration processes ODR as immediately as possible.

Fighting/Physical Aggression:

Student engages in actions involving serious physical contact where injury may occur (e.g., hitting, punching, hitting with an object, kicking, hair pulling, scratching, etc.).

Possible

CONSEQUENCES:

- Parent/student/Admin conference
- Avoidance Agreement
- 5 days after school w/ dean/rp coordinator
- Change of Schedule
- In-school suspension
- Daily Behavior Check
- Out of School Suspension
- Expulsion

Safe interactions on Social Media

- Be respectful of your actions
 - Are your comments respectful of others?
 - Stop and think of what you are planning to post. Can it have negative consequences?
 - Think, should you be browsing someone's account if you are having conflict?
 - Be responsible with your social media accounts, don't let it turn into cyber bullying!



YONDR pouches



This is a **CELL PHONE FREE** campus

- 1) Use your **YONDR** pouch every day ***(yes, even if you do not have a phone)**
- 2) Ensure your phone is **OFF** & locked in **YONDR** pouch
- 3) **YONDR** pouches are to also be used **ALL DAY** (EduCare program)
 - a) ***ALL** Phones not in the pouch will be confiscated and placed in the MIT office until parent pick up

NOTE- *Wireless headphones and smart watches are **not** allowed*

Dismissal

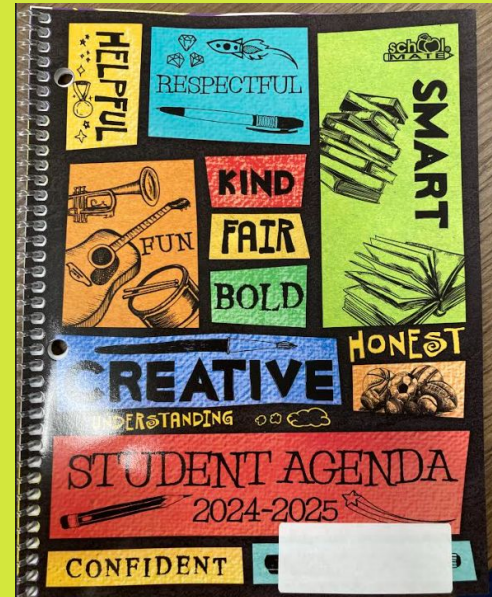
If in EduCare you have 5 minutes to get to the sign-in location
