winnett Online Campus (GOC)—the school system's full-time diploma-granting school with grades K-12 offers a flexible learning environment, extensive support from teachers and counselors, individualized instruction, and a full range of courses. GOC students must meet all graduation requirements for credits and assessments.

Unlike the traditional setting, GOC students work online at the time of day that works best for their schedule. Face-to-face meetings occur on campus for hands-on labs, interactive learning labs, and testing.

During these campus visits, along with other opportunities such as on and off-campus Rich Experiences, students form study groups and friendships while enhancing 21st century skills.

Graduate Gwinnett

The Graduate Gwinnett Program is an innovative approach offering flexibility for students to complete the required course work for graduation. Students enter a unique and individualized online learning environment with face-to-face support as needed.

After an orientation to the program, students complete one online course at a time during a 20-day session. In addition, on campus or virtual sessions are provided with teachers.

GCPS residents who have previously dropped out of high school can contact <u>Jennifer Tennant</u> to inquire about joining the Graduate Gwinnett program. To date, over 550 students have graduated through this program.

Frequently Asked Questions





How is Gwinnett Online Campus different from traditional public schools?

Gwinnett Online Campus courses are similar to traditional courses in the following ways: there are lessons, homework, due dates, class discussions, tests, scheduled online CLASS time (live class time), and teachers available to students throughout the duration of the course. The difference is that these activities occur over the internet and students may complete course work during the time of day that best fits their schedules, except for scheduled CLASS sessions and face-to-face requirements. Students will need a computer and reliable internet access in order to complete their online course work.

Will full-time Gwinnett Online Campus students be required to check in every day online?

Students are given a course schedule to follow and due dates that must be met. However, students may certainly work ahead in their courses. Student success is performance-based and is measured by whether or not a student is current in his or her courses and is showing mastery of the course content.

Will Advanced Placement classes be offered?

Yes. Gwinnett Online Campus offers classes at the college preparatory, honors, gifted and Advanced Placement levels.

Will the diploma from the online school be accepted for college admission?

Yes. The diploma from Gwinnett Online Campus will be accepted just as the diploma of any other Gwinnett County public high school is accepted.

Supplemental Program at Gwinnett Online Campus

Through the Gwinnett Online Campus Supplemental Program, students enrolled at a local high school may take up to five courses as part of their regular school schedule without paying a fee. Students may also choose to pay tuition and take additional courses after school or during the summer— to get ahead or make room in their schedule for electives.
