Class Schedules

- Student schedules are now live and are finalized
- We ask that parents and students do not send emails with questions or requests to teachers, counselors or administrators at this time
- We appreciate your patience, as many changes are still being made



SHIRTS/TOPS EXPECTATIONS

- Students must wear collared polo shirts in the permitted colors
- Polos must be tucked in
- Undershirts are permitted but must be solid colors and tucked in as well
- Shirts should fit appropriately
- Shirts may not be balled/bundled or tied up



PANTS/BOTTOMS EXPECTATIONS

- Students must wear khaki or navy blue pants, shorts, skirts
- No cut offs, frayed or torn pants
- Belt buckles may not have initials, flags, or logos on them if worn
- Pants must fit and may not be too baggy or too tight
- Pants must be an appropriate length and not drag on the ground, be too high, or show student's underpants

All Aviators must be at school on time and report to their scheduled homeroom by 8:30 a.m.

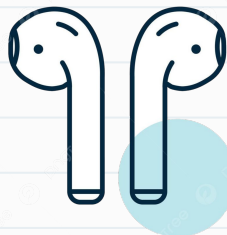
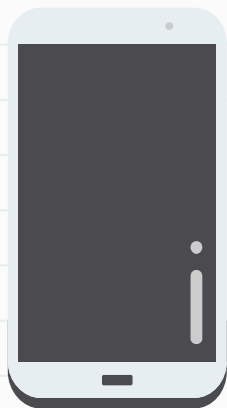
Students that are tardy will receive detention and must meet with Ms. McClaren.

Cell Phones/ Headphones

The goal of our new cell phone policy is to cultivate a distraction free campus culture of authentic connectedness and focus.

- Students are permitted to use their cell phones and headphones during lunch and afterschool.
- Students may not use cell phones or headphones once they have entered campus before the morning bell rings
- Cell phones and headphones are to be left in backpacks or they will be confiscated and parents/guardians must come to pick them up.

CAFETERIA

All students are eligible for free lunch. Students must have their school-issued ID to scan or input their school ID to receive their lunch.

BRING YOUR LUNCH

Refrigerators and microwaves are available to store and heat up lunches in the MPR. It is everyone's responsibility to keep the refrigerator and microwave clean.

FOOD DELIVERIES NOT PERMITTED

Students are not allowed to receive food deliveries from outside vendors: GrubHub, DoorDash, and Uber Eats. Only parents / guardians are allowed to drop food off for their child and must drop it off in the front office with prior approval.

Log Entries

HMSA implements the log entry system to hold students accountable and keep parents/ families informed.

Students may receive log entries for the following reasons (but not limited to):

- Dress code violations
- Unacceptable behavior
- Pattern of missing homework
- Missing class supplies
- No Chromebook
- Phone being confiscated
- Not following school rules

Log entries are part of the HMSA way. This system allows students to be held accountable for their actions and allow for improvement. Parents/Guardians are kept informed as they are a key part of the network for student success.

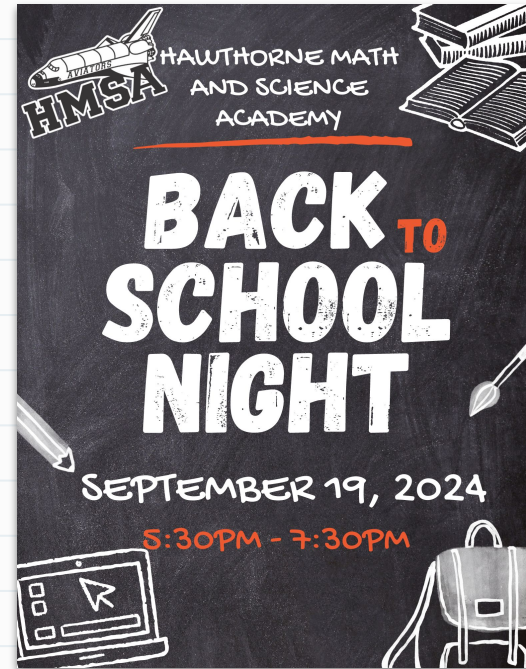

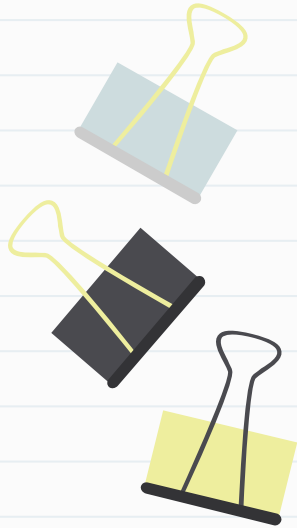
