



## Peru Service Trip: March 23 – 30, 2025

### Mission

We will be working through Inca Link International to bring the gospel and the love of Jesus to unreached communities in the Trujillo, Peru. Partnering with various local churches and ministries, we will be engaging in: construction, sports and relational evangelism with teens, VBS with children, worship, and compassion ministries to the poor.

### Goals

- To serve, love, and share the gospel cross-culturally with the Peruvian people.
- To augment the discipleship ministry of the local ministries in Trujillo.
- To encourage the local churches where they exist.
- To help students gain a passion and vision for missions.

### Itinerary

March 23	SFO to Lima
March 24	Lima to Trujillo
March 29	Trujillo to Lima
March 30	Lima to SFO

### Accommodations/Food

In Trujillo, we will be staying in a secure camp location with bunkhouses. In Lima, we will stay at a local hotel near the airport. All meals will be provided.

### Cost - \$2,775

The cost for this trip covers airfare to Trujillo, Peru and back, lodging, meals, and ministry costs. Students will have to cover the additional cost of pre-trip vaccinations (no vaccinations are required for travel to Trujillo, Peru, but it is recommended to be up to date on all routine vaccinations (Tetanus, Hepatitis A & B, etc.), meals at airports, and personal spending money.

### Application Process

The Peru Service trip is open to 10<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> grades only. To apply, please submit the 2025 Service Trip Online Application. The 2025 Service Trip Application is for current full-time students only. The application link will be posted in Canvas in the Grade Level Classrooms. Applications will only be accepted during the following time frame: Thursday, August 29, 3:00PM, through Tuesday, September 10, 11:59PM.

### Selection Process

The team will consist of a maximum of 50 students, plus 10 adult chaperones. After applications are submitted, participants will be selected based on the following trip-specific criteria: a heart for missions, cross-cultural sensitivity, gifting, a servant's attitude, and previous service experience. There is a cultural immersion experience, so the ability to speak Spanish is highly desirable, but not required. Be advised that it is a physically rigorous trip. Applicants must be open to being challenged and stretched outside of their comfort zone while maintaining a positive attitude. All applicants will be notified of their placement on October 11.

Due to the conditions of Trujillo, Peru, students with life-threatening medical conditions may not be able to attend. You may want to discuss your condition with the trip leaders prior to applying.
