Application Process

Selection Process

The team will consist of a maximum of 40 students, plus 6 adult chaperones. After applications are submitted, participants will be selected based on the following trip-specific criteria: ability to work well alongside others, a servant's attitude, and willingness to make a difference. Be advised that it is a physically rigorous trip. Applicants must be open to being challenged and stretched outside of their comfort zone while maintaining a positive attitude. All applicants will be notified by October 11.
