



## San Francisco Service Trip: March 24 – 28, 2025

### Mission

Our team will serve with San Francisco City Impact, an inner-city ministry that began in 1984 with the dream of seeing a spiritual awakening in the Tenderloin. What began as an afternoon handing out sandwiches on the street has grown into a multifaceted ministry serving the immediate needs of the community in these areas: poverty, children, and hunger. Our students will serve through tangible acts of love and kindness such as feeding the hungry (Rescue Mission, Meal Deliveries), clothing the naked (Thrift Store), educating the children (School) loving our neighbor (Adopt a Building) and making disciples (connecting people back to the church).

### Goals

Students will provide service to inner-city residents alongside other leaders and participants. Team members will likely experience settings that may be uncomfortable, and they may be around others who may make them feel uncomfortable. This is not an opportunity for team members to compare levels of bravado, but to bring love and compassion where there has been mostly emptiness and disdain. Students will be inspired, encouraged and equipped to embody a heart of service wherever they go.

### Itinerary

March 24 Depart TKA by bus at 8:30 a.m.; arrive and receive orientation  
March 24- 28 Hands-on ministry in various departments  
March 28 Hands-on ministry; depart SF City Impact by bus at 3:30 p.m.

### Accommodations/Food

We will be sleeping on bunk beds in the SF City Impact Building. Students will bring sleeping bags and pillows. All food will be provided by City Impact.

### Cost - \$815

This covers food, lodging, transportation, and any the supplies and materials for ministry projects. Any expenses for extra food or souvenirs purchased by team members will not be covered by the school.

### Application Process

The San Francisco Service trip is open to all High School Students. To apply, please submit the 2025 Service Trip Application. The 2025 Service Trip Application is for current full-time students only. The application link will be posted in Canvas in the Grade Level Classrooms. Applications will only be accepted during the following time frame: Thursday, August 29, 3:00PM, through Tuesday, September 10, 11:59PM.

### Selection Process

The team will consist of a maximum of 60 students, plus 12 adult chaperones. After applications are submitted, participants will be selected based on the following trip-specific criteria: a heart for missions in the inner-city, gifting, a servant's attitude, and previous service experience. All applicants will be notified by October 11.
