# 4. Application Documents

Physician's certificate of health	A certificate must be obtained stating that the applicant has no problem with school life in regard to their health.	
Progress report	The report must include records from the past three years up to the present.  *Internal students enrolled in Kansai International Academy Kindergarten/Sakura International School are not required to submit a progress report.  *External students must submit their progress reports online via the application form.	
School report	Please request a school report from an individual who knows your child well, such as a homeroom teacher, principal, counselor, etc.  *The school report may be turned in as a data file or a physical document.  *Internal students enrolled in Kansai International Academy Kindergarten/Sakura International School are not required to submit their school reports. Our kindergartens will send the reports to our elementary school.  *For external students, the school report must be sent to our elementary school from your child's school by email (info-sis-elementary@faculty.kansai-intlschool.jp) as a data file or mailed in a sealed envelope.	

# 5. Entrance Examination Fee

An entrance examination fee of 30,000 yen must be paid. Those with students of Kansai International Academy/Sakura International School may make the payment via the school's Platinum School (<a href="https://my.ptsc.jp/kansai-intlsch">https://my.ptsc.jp/kansai-intlsch</a>) during the application period.

### (\*1) [Education and facility enhancement fees]

A monthly IB cooperation fee of ¥20,000 is included for the school to apply for IB PYP.

# (\*2)[Bus operation fee]

At least 4 students must be registered for the school bus to be available.

## (\*3)[ESL·JSL]

Students must be enrolled in ESL/JSL if requested by the school.

### [Other]

- Fees for class materials (such as text books), field trips, and classes held by third parties such as electives, will be paid on a monthly basis.
- Summer school is held for 3 weeks during summer (optional: additional fee required).
- Fees including the admission fee, facility fee, tuition are non-refundable for any reason. Other miscellaneous fees may be charged at any time.
- Due to changes in the economic situation or national policies (such as changes in consumption tax or corporate tax), fees including the tuition may be revised accordingly. In this case, we will inform you as soon as possible.
- A sibling discount will be applied if the child admitted for enrollment is the second child or above and has a sibling enrolled at Sakura International School Elementary. The tuition for the child admitted for enrollment is half the original amount.
- Internal students may be eligible for a scholarship based on incase status. Please contact our school for more details.
