- Community service club activities (<u>not meetings</u>)
- Community service through a religious institution (performances are not included)
- Political campaign activities
- Helping at a hospital, convalescent home or orphanage
- Contributing to a toy drive/food drive

Examples of what is NOT community service/volunteer hours:

- Sales of items for fund-raisers
- Volunteer work during regular school hours
- What would be considered normal extracurricular (or co-curricular) activities, such as sports and sports related activities (managers), cheerleading participating in school performances activities that are related to a class
- Working for an individual teacher (or teachers) such as grading papers, cleaning out closets, rearranging room
- Service where the recipient is a family member or where a family member supervises the service
- Tutoring individual students
- Babysitting/yard work for individuals (unless there is no pay, for a non-family member)
- UIL competitions
