Recognizing the significance of the student voice, the ULUSD Board of Education is committed to actively seeking and valuing students' perspectives, ideas, and reactions. As part of this commitment, the Board is currently in the process of selecting a high school student from ULUSD to serve as a student board member for the 2024-2025 school year, thereby amplifying student representation in decision-making processes.

Recommended Criteria:

- Current 10th or 11th grade
- Minimum 2.5 GPA
- Community Involvement
- Communicative Skills
- Ability to Commit to the Responsibilities of the Position

Student Board Member role:

The Student Board Member attends all ULUSD Board meetings to collect feedback for presentation during school board meetings. During open sessions, they articulate insights from the student perspective. Additionally, the Student Member collaborates and communicates with their respective principal. Ultimately, their role entails serving as a liaison between the board and students, ensuring that student voices inform decision-making processes.
