DETAILS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Order forms will be sent home in advance. • The purchase cost is \$20 per student; bring the form and money on March 14. Forms coming soon. • Students will receive the class picture in June.
CRITERIA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All 8th grade students are eligible for the picture unless otherwise determined by the administration. • Dress code guidelines will be enforced.

CLASS FIELD TRIP, SIX FLAGS, Vallejo, CA	
DATE and LOCATION	April 2025: (Depart Pine Hollow: approx. 9am; Arrive back at Pine Hollow: approx. 6pm)
DETAILS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To attend, the cost will be \$60 per student with ASB and \$70 per student without ASB. Price includes bus, park entrance fee, and lunch. Students with Six Flags passes only pay \$10. • Students with a season pass must provide a photo of the pass with their permission slip. • Students who do not attend the trip are expected to attend school.
CRITERIA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All 8th Grade students are invited to attend the trip. However, students become ineligible to attend several weeks prior if they incur <u>any</u> of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Administrative Suspension (In-School or Out-of-School) ○ Any missed Restore Time (Time can be made up prior to the event) ○ A class suspension given by two different teachers (Must include an agreed upon administration-teacher-student-parent meeting within one week or prior to the event) <p>A student can complete 6 hours of restorative (community) service approved by the administration to make up for one: class, in-school or out-of-school suspension</p>

PROMOTION CEREMONY

DETAILS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The ceremony will be at 9:00 am on the Blacktop. Students are expected to dress their best. Parents/guardians and family members attending the ceremony will need to bring their own chairs - we will have seating only for the 8th grade students. No parking will be available on campus; carpooling or other mode of transportation is strongly encouraged. 8th graders are dismissed for the day at the end of the ceremony.
CRITERIA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In conjunction with MDUSD practice, eligibility criteria for participation in the promotion ceremony requires that students meet the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <u>Academic Requirements</u>: Students must have passing grades to participate in promotion, or must receive special permission from the Pine Hollow administration to participate if they do not have passing grades. <u>Behavioral Requirements</u>: Students with significant behavioral issues during 4th quarter may be prohibited from participating in the promotion ceremony. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Administrative Suspension (In-School or Out-of-School) Any missed Restore Time (Time can be made up prior to the event) A class suspension given by two different teachers (Must include an agreed upon administration-teacher-student-parent meeting within one week or prior to the event) <p>A student can complete 6 hours of restorative (community) service approved by the administration to make up for one: class, in-school or out-of-school suspension</p>
