What is ACCESS?

- State required assessment in the four skills (reading, writing, speaking and listening) for students in ESL
- Mostly administered online
- All Multilingual Learners, even those who have declined services and those who have just arrived, must sit for ACCESS
- Teachers use multiple measures including a state mandated cut off score (4.5 of 6) to determine if students exit from or remain in the program.

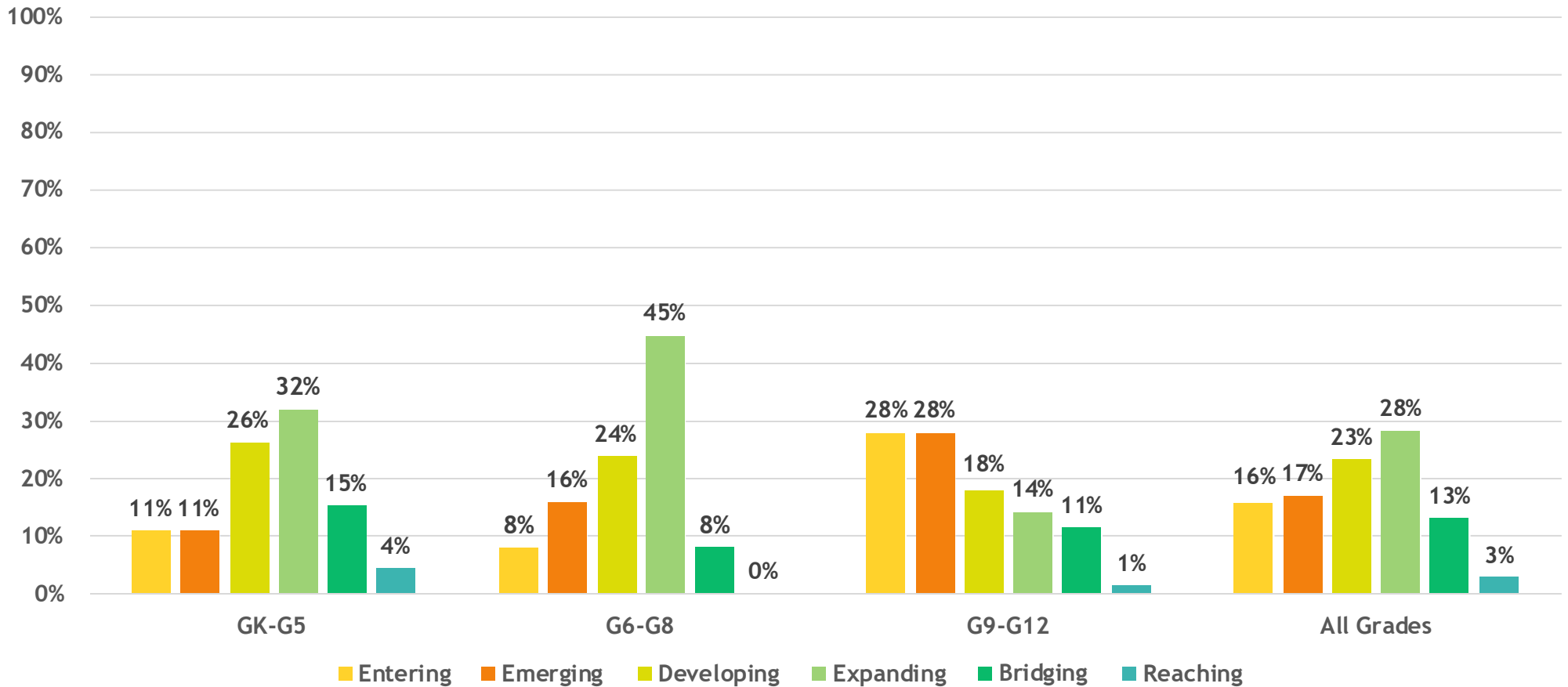

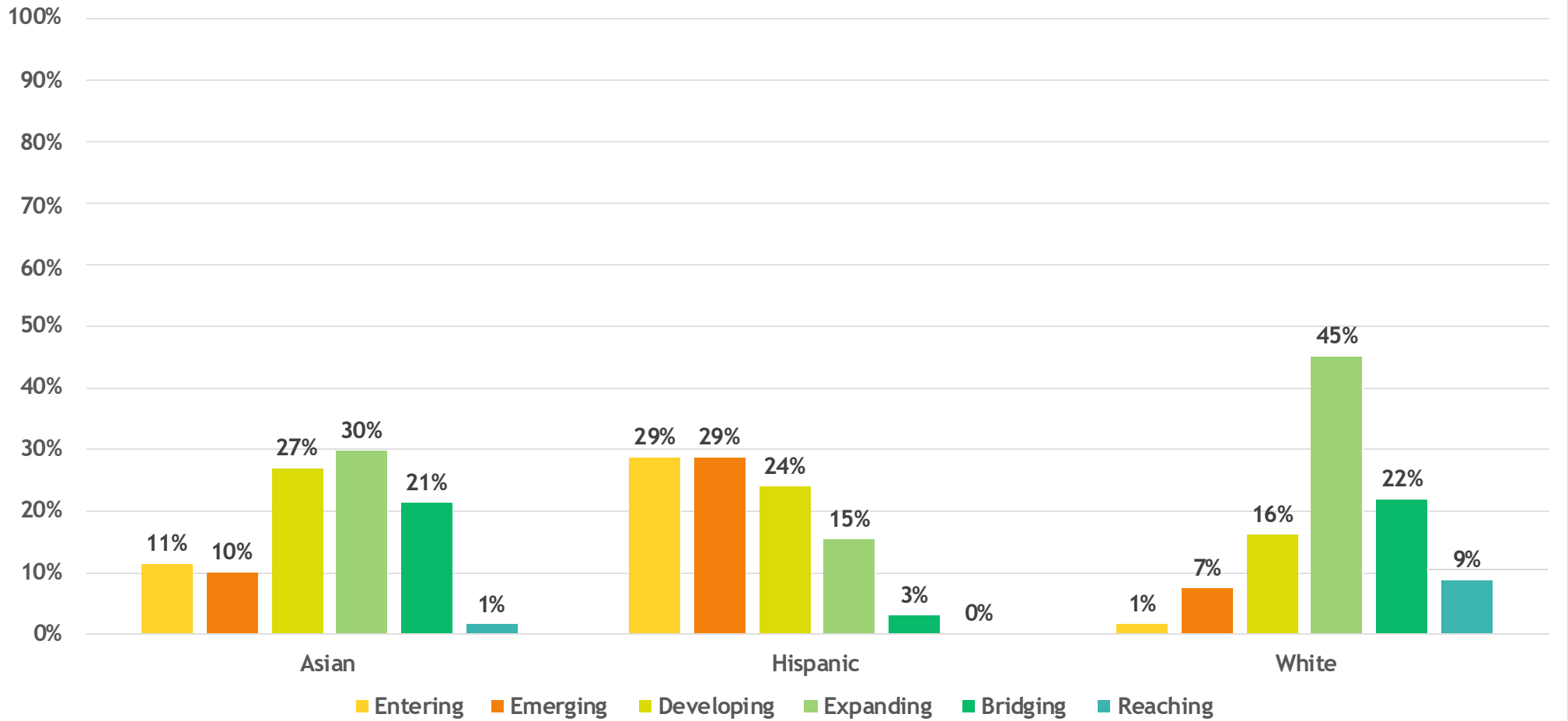

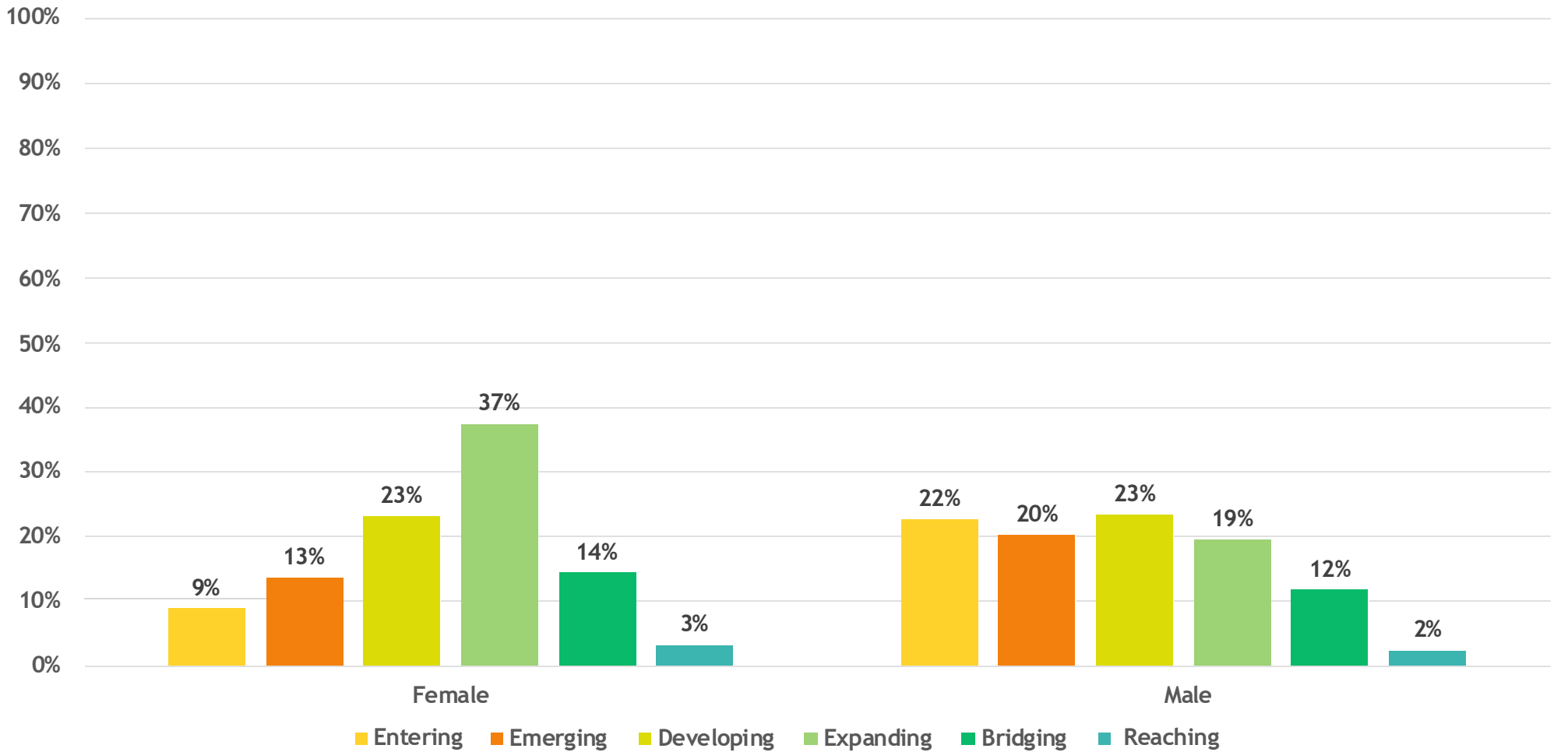

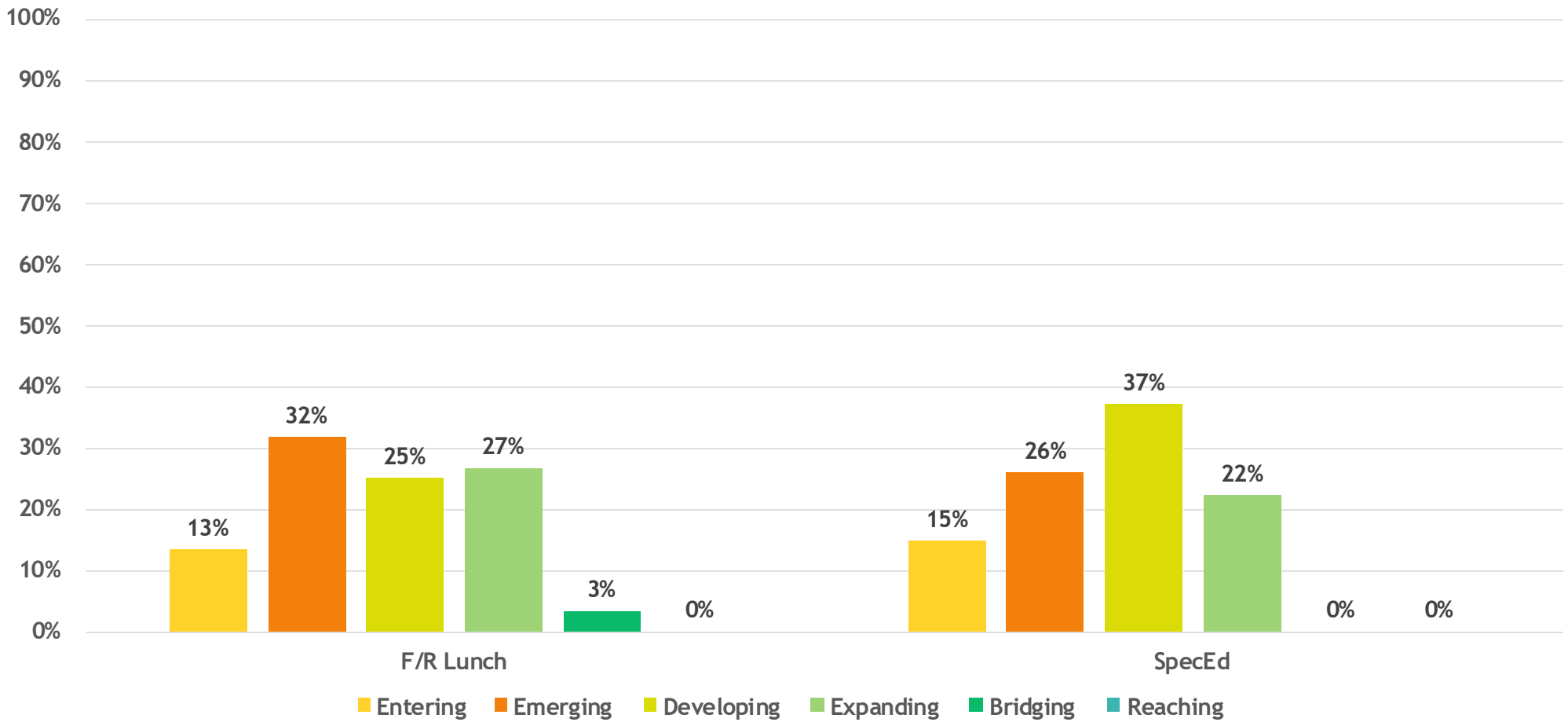

- Strong district support
- Small group instruction
- Strong co-teaching in ELA at middle school
- Expanding course options and support systems at PHS

Areas for Growth:

- Continue to increase outside of school day supports for students
- Set up ongoing parental support groups for under-resourced families
- Expand number of staff who are SEI trained

Next steps for supporting Multilingual learners

- Continue online SEI training for PPS general education staff with an emphasis to train more grades 6 – 12 staff.
- Implement broader supports for students at the middle school with the addition of our second ESL teacher. Thank you!
