**Curriculum:** Students are offered a rigorous learning experience, with opportunities for movement into more challenging coursework. There is something for everybody; from an updated STEM program to a thriving visual and performing arts program, our students are able to explore their interests and passions. We use an A/B block schedule with four 75-minute blocks per day on a two-day alternating cycle. A 35-minute “flex block” happens every day and includes advisory and academic support.

**Career & Technical Education:** Partnering with [Portland School of Arts and Technology \(PATHS\)](#) and [Westbrook Regional Vocational Centers \(WRVC\)](#), students in grades 11th and 12th gain valuable technical and career skills and integrated credits

**Dual Enrollment:** Students may enroll in college-level courses sponsored by the University of Maine System and the Maine Community College System, including the Spring Ahead Program at Southern Maine Community College.

**Career Pathways:** Students explore career interests and experiential learning opportunities through connections with local professionals, businesses, and community partners in their field of interest.

**Accreditation:** New England Association of Schools & Colleges (2028)

**Honors & Advanced Placement Courses:** All College Prep, Honors (noted as 4), AP, and college level classes receive additional points in the weighted GPA calculation. We do not limit the number of AP courses a student can take.

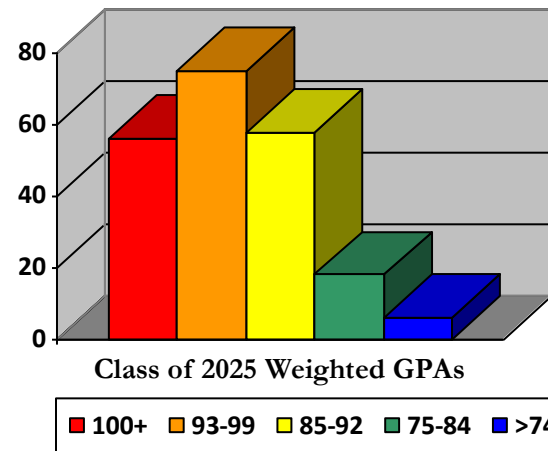
