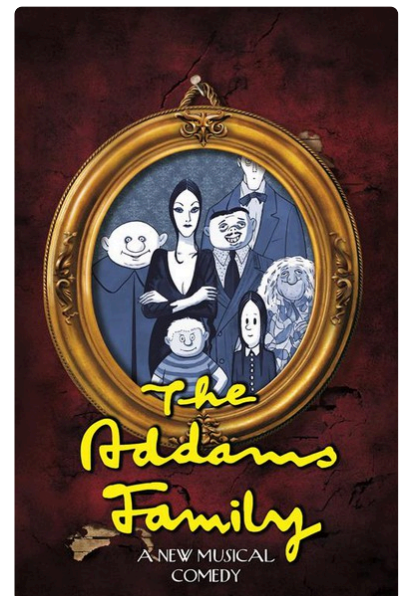

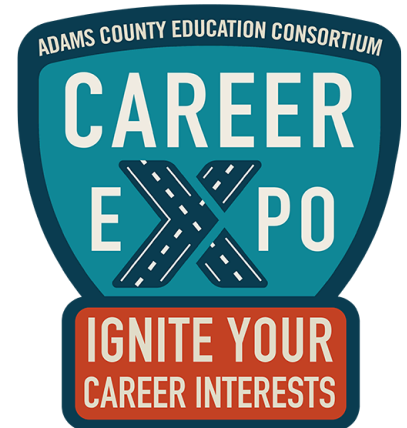
8th Grade Career Expo

Interims serve as a bridge between formative and summative assessments and can provide valuable information for data-driven instruction. The interims offer a snapshot of progress against a set of uniform standards within the quarter.

Thank you to all the teachers who provided feedback during the Interim Assessment After Action Review! We will have another After Action Review after the third quarter.

District Interim 1 Data (on 10/18)

What should we do with this data? How can this data be used to inform my instructional practice?

Some possible questions to ask:

- How might this information guide our IDT work? MTSS?
- What was the data for my school as compared to the district data overall?
- We analyzed our school data. What were our highest leverage grade level gaps? Was there a pattern across grade levels?
- What opportunities do we have for reteach? Is guided discourse or modeling most appropriate for closing the highest leverage grade level gap? What targeted supports might be needed?
