If you haven't yet voted, but would like more information on the issues, <u>click here</u>. If you aren't registered to vote, you still can do so now through Election Day. You can register online here: https://bit.ly/3U9ZC1t or at voter service and polling centers between now and next Tuesday.

The deadline to mail ballots has passed, but you can still return completed ballots via ballot drop-off boxes, or a vote center designated for in-person ballot drop-off, by next Tuesday, by 7 p.m.

Here is a <u>list of 24-hour ballot drop box locations</u> in Adams County. Ballots do not require stamps if they are placed in a drop box. If you don't live in Adams County, please find a ballot drop off box in the county where you live this weekend!

A reminder about nursing requirements for field trips
