

Suspected and Confirmed Concussion Protocol Flowchart

School

Parents/Guardians

Licensed Healthcare Providers

Health Aides/Athletic Trainer:
Following injury and basic first aid provided, school staff will:

- Notify parent(s)/guardian(s)
- Provide them with:
 - [Head Injury Report and Head Injury Referral](#)
- Staff will complete:
 - [Student Accident Report](#)
 - Add student to Concussion Spreadsheet

Staff will receive from parent/guardian:

- Completed [Head Injury Referral](#) or MD note indicating next steps

Notify all teachers, counselor, AP of diagnosis and academic accommodations:

- [Recommended School Accommodations](#)

Allow time as required in:

- [Return to Learn Protocol](#)
- [Return to Play Protocol](#)

If current athlete, staff will notify coach/AD:

- Place a Medical Temp Hold [in SportsNet](#)

Once cleared by HCP to begin, AT will start the:

- [Return to Play Protocol](#)

Cleared by HCP to return to full academics/physical activity

Receive, read and sign:

- [Head Injury Report and Head Injury Referral](#)
- Including linked documents regarding [Return to Learn](#), [Recommended School Accommodations](#) and [Return to Play Protocol](#)

Consult with: Licensed Healthcare Provider and provide [Head Injury Referral](#)

If student is not progressing or has return of symptoms, consult with Licensed Healthcare Provider and provide additional documentation to school staff

Should symptoms return, inform parent(s)/guardian(s) and return to previous stage of protocol(s)

Diagnose student.
Complete and sign:

- [Head Injury Referral](#) form
- Additional documents as needed
 - [Recommended School Accommodations](#)
 - [Return to Play Protocol](#)

- Consult with school staff as needed
- Follow up with student, parent(s)/guardian(s) and school staff for clearance
