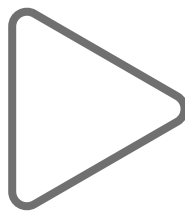

Mapleton students receive millions of dollars in scholarships to pursue their dreams

Congratulations to Mapleton's 2024 scholarship recipients!

Last week, graduates and their families gathered in the Skyview Student Center for the district's annual Scholarship Breakfast. This year, Mapleton celebrated 103 seniors who received more than \$6.8 million in total scholarship earnings!

Victor P., from Mapleton Early Career Prep, received the prestigious Boettcher Scholarship, and Jasbeth H., also from Mapleton Early Career Prep received the Daniels Scholarship, a highly competitive, full four-year scholarship. York International School senior Natalia O. received the highest scholarship earnings this year with an astounding total of \$648,000!

Additionally, the Mapleton Education Foundation awarded 30 seniors scholarships this year, providing a combined \$250,000 to support graduates in pursuing their post-secondary dreams. Interim Updates 2024-25 School Year

Pearson will continue to support the ELA and Math quarterly interims. As we continue to focus on student learning results, the interim helps demonstrate grade-level standards support planning and identifies gaps in understanding.

Thank you for your feedback throughout the year and during the After-Action Reviews following the first and third quarter ELA and Math interims. We have made some adjustments in real time and there will also be some changes for the upcoming school year.

Second grade will no longer take the ELA/Math interim and second grade teachers will focus on foundational skills on the Collaborative Days.

High School: Because of the timing of P/SAT and practice PSAT tests with Horizons, High School interims for Quarter 4 ELA and Math are optional. Also, because the interim is aligned with the standards we teach in our curricular resources, and is summative in nature, high school teachers can use the interim in place of a final exam for a course.
