



## TIMBERLINE HIGH SCHOOL BOOSTER CLUB Scholarship Program Guidelines 2024-2025 School Year

Applications must be received in the THS Counseling Office by end of school day on **April 11, 2025**.  
No late applications will be accepted.

### 1. Sponsorship

The scholarship program is sponsored by the Timberline High School Booster Club. Funds are generated from the contributions of our members and Booster Club fund-raising activities that take place during the year.

### 2. Eligibility

A candidate must meet each of the following conditions:

- a. Be a senior, in good standing, at Timberline High School.
- b. Plan to attend any accredited 2- or 4-year university, college, community college, or vocational/technical institute beginning in the fall of the student's graduating year.
- c. Parent/Guardian must be an active/lifetime THS Booster Club member or Board member (Prior to December 31 of the current school year).

### 3. Scholarship awards

Three scholarships valued at **\$500** will be awarded to selected THS graduating seniors. Scholarships will be applied towards school tuition, fees, and costs. Scholarships must be used during the school year following high school graduation. Payment will be made directly to the educational institution upon the award recipient's submission of a statement to the Booster Club Treasurer.

### 4. Criteria for Selection

In awarding scholarships, the Timberline High School Booster Club shall evaluate the candidates based on the following criteria:

- a. Character, integrity, and personal qualities.
- b. Embody a well-balanced high school experience.
- c. Academic achievement.
- d. Additional, meaningful participation in an activity outside of school (work, community service, volunteer, etc.)
- e. Essay must be typed with double spacing. The font must be no larger than 12 on Times New Roman.

### 5. Application must include the following:

- a. Completion of the attached scholarship application form, including the blank rubric & scoresheet.

### 6. Submittal of applications

- a. Applications must be delivered to the THS Counseling Office or e-mailed to [dboesenberg@nthurston.k12.wa.us](mailto:dboesenberg@nthurston.k12.wa.us), to be placed in the Booster mailbox, by end of school day on **April 11, 2025**. **No late applications will be accepted.**
- b. Applications can be obtained at the Timberline High School career center or on the THS Booster Club page, and The Booster Club Facebook page.
- c. Scholarships will be presented at the THS Senior Honors and Awards Program in May/June.
