Welcome back to school, Warriorsi I am Mr. Schlueter, the West Branch Middle School principal. My entire staff and I are looking forward to meeting our new students and getting this school year off to a good start!

The Middle School runs on two schedules, One for Grades 6-7 and one for Grades 3-5. The start and dismissal times for both schedules have changed this year:

- Grades 6-7
 - Start Time 7:40
 - Dismissal Time: 2:50
- Grades 3-5
 - Start Time 8:55
 - Dismissal Time 3:40

The <u>WBMS Open House</u> for all grades is Monday, August 26, from 3:30 - 5:30 pm. Please note that <u>no one will be</u> <u>permitted to enter the building prior to 3:30 pm</u> in order to allow teachers time to prepare for the open house.



Car Rider Procedures - Grades 3-5

- Car Rider drop-off and pick-up is in the back of the building.
- Please unload your child once your vehicle stops anywhere along the sidewalk.
- Do not wait until you are directly outside the doors to unload your child.
- Grades 3-5 School Day: 8:55 3:40
 - Doors will open at 8:30 for car riders to enter the building. I recommend that students arrive by 8:45 in order to have time to prepare for the day.
 - We are implementing the same car pick-up routing system that was used last year.
 - Cars entering from Ellet Road will turn left at the first drive and circle around the JV softball field to line up.
 - Cars entering from Beloit-Snodes Road will turn left and then right at the stop signs, pass between the middle school and high school parking lots, turn right at the drive, and circle around the JV softball field to line up.
 - This will create 1 line for all cars with no need to merge. Please see the below map.

<u>Car Rider Tags - Grades 3-5 (only)</u>

- Car Rider Tags are required to pick up your child in the car line after school. All Car Rider Tags will be free this year. Please take only what you anticipate that you will need.
- Additional Car Rider Tags may be picked up in the office anytime during the school year.
- Please display the car tag on the passenger side of the dashboard of your car when you
 pick up your child. This helps us speed up the dismissal procedure and provides added
 security.
- If you need to pick up your child, but do not have a car tag, you will have to come into the
 office to sign your child out. This is not to be a normal procedure, only an exception.
 Please sign out your child no later than 3:00 so that they may be called to the office.
 prior to the end of the school day.
- Car Rider Tags will be available at Open House on August 26th.

Car Rider Procedures - Grades 6-7


Car Rider drop-off and pick-up is in the back of the building.

Do not wait until you are directly outside the doors to unload your child...

- Grades 6-7 School Day: 7:40 2:50
 - O Doors will open at 7:10 for car riders to enter the building. I recommend students arrive by 7:30 in order to have time to prepare for the day.
 - We are implementing the same car pick-up routing system as last year.
 - Cars entering from Ellet Road will turn left at the first drive and circle around the JV softball field to line up.
 - Cars entering from Beloit-Snodes Road will turn right and the circle around and pick up students in the parking lot adjacent to the playground in the back of the building.
 - This will create 2 lines for pick-up.
 - Please inform your child which line you will be in.

Attendance and Tardies

In order for children to be successful in school, they need to be here! Attendance is an important part of a student's academic, social, and emotional success. It is recommended that your student arrives to school by the below times so that they can get prepared in their classrooms for a great school day.

- 7:30 am grades 6-7
- 8:45 am grades 3-5

Students will be marked tardy if they arrive after the following times:

- 7:40 am grades 6-7
- 8:55 am grades 3-5

Any time a child is absent, his/her parent must call the child off at (330)938-4300. Upon the child's return to school, he/she must provide a doctor's excuse or written note.


<u>ClassDojo</u>

ClassDojo is the communication platform that we will be using at VVB Middle School this year. Your child's teacher, as well as the principal and school counselor will be able to communicate with you via ClassDojo... It is a free service.

Dress Code

A complete copy is available in the student handbook which can be found on the school website under the "Parents" tab. Please keep in mind the following:

- No pajama pants are permitted
- Hats/Hoods are not allowed to be worn in the building
- No clothes with excessive holes
- Shorts/Skirts should be at least mid-thigh in length
- Flip flops are permitted, but other shoes must be sent in for recess and/or gym
- The principal is the final decision maker in all matters concerning the dress code.



No Toys or Electronics

To limit distractions, toys including, but not limited to, spinners, poppets, and pokemon cards are not permitted in the school. Any electronic devices that are sent with students are to remain in their lockers or classroom cubbies unless otherwise directed by their teacher.

Any student who does not follow these rules will have the toys/devices taken by the teachers and they will be kept in the office until the parent picks them up. Thank you for your understanding in helping to create classrooms conducive to learning!

Specials Rotation

Grades 3-5 will have an X-Y-Z specials schedule. Students will take P.E. all year and will take STEM, Music, Art, and Library (Grades 3 & 4) or Computers (Grade 5) for one semester.

- 1. Physical Education (P.E.)
- 2. STÉM
- 3. Art
- 4. Music
- 5. Library (3rd and 4th grade)
- 6. Computers (5th Grade)

Teachers will notify you of the special that your child has on each day. If school is cancelled, the special your child had scheduled on that day will be rescheduled for the day of return so that no specials are skipped.
