

TEDxStart Rite Schools Abuja for COBIS Students

Terms and Conditions

TEDxStart Rite Schools Abuja will take place on Friday 7 February 2025 at Start Rite Schools Abuja.

Participants

- TEDxStart Rite Schools Abuja is open to COBIS member schools. Each school with a registered COBIS account should participate as an individual school.
- The event is for students aged 12-17 as of 7 February 2025.

Registration

- Schools must register for the event via the online form on the COBIS website.
- All bookings must be made by school staff.
- The cost per student is £100.
- From each school, 1 member of staff per 5 students may attend for free. Any additional members of staff will be required to pay a £50 fee.
- The student fee covers participation and catering during the event. Please note, travel to/from Abuja, and accommodation within Abuja is **not** included in this fee.
- Registration will close on Thursday 12 December 2024.
- There are a limited number of places and these will be allocated on a first come-first served basis. When places have been filled, additional registrations will be added to a waiting list.
- Schools must confirm how many students they would like to attend in the registration form.
- If a registered school wishes to withdraw from this event, they must confirm before Thursday 12 December 2024. To cancel a booking, please notify students@cobis.org.uk.

Finance

- Schools will be invoiced directly for places booked, not parents or guardians.
- Schools must pay the invoice in a timely manner, in accordance with the timeline specified on all invoices.

Travel and Accommodation

- Schools must not make any arrangements to travel to or stay in Abuja until their place has been formally confirmed by COBIS and the host school.
- Schools must take out the appropriate insurance policies in order to attend the event; the policy should include travel, medical and cancellation insurance as well as anything else as required by your school or region.

Cancellation

- COBIS and the host school reserve the right to cancel this event if insufficient bookings are received, or if travel to the host country becomes inadvisable.

Data Sharing and Processing

- In order to administer this event, COBIS/the host school will collect student names, ages, dietary requirements, and access requirements, as well as passport details if required for visa support letters. Please ensure that you have obtained the correct consent from pupils or guardians when providing this information. COBIS may ask for evidence of this consent.
- COBIS will also collect lead teacher, head teacher and finance names and contact details. This data will be shared with the host school for the administration of the event. COBIS and the host school have a data sharing agreement in place to protect the transfer of this information. This information will not be passed by COBIS to any other parties.
- COBIS will retain data and information in line with their [Privacy Policy](#). The host school will retain data and information in line with their [Data Protection Policy](#).
