Liberty High School is considered to be a CLOSED CAMPUS. Students are not to leave school ground during the day unless they are dismissed for apportion of the school day by written permission, verified parent telephone call to the attendance office (425-837-4810), or special administrative approval.

For students requesting the opportunity to leave campus during the lunch hour, the following policies will apply:

- Students must be in grade 10-12 ONLY, no exceptions.
- The student and parents agree this privilege will be withdrawn if tardiness or absenteeism becomes a problem.
- Student must have good previous semester attendance records.
- Students approved leave campus at lunch will be expected have this form on file, signed by their parent or guardian approving them to leave campus.
- Parent/Guardian must provide a daytime telephone number.
- Students agree to follow and uphold our good neighbor policy, to act in a safe manner, and to follow the posted parking and driving guidelines. Failure to do so may result in the revocation of this privilege.

We do hereby request the release of our child _____ during their regularly scheduled lunch period in order that the student may enjoy the privilege of being off campus. It is understood and agree that while the student is off campus, they are not within the protective custody of the school and that the school is not responsible for the supervision, safety and custody of the student during these times.

In consideration of being granted the privilege, we do hereby release the Issaquah School District #411, its agents and employees of any and all liability which may arise as result of activities engaged in by my child while so absent from the school premises. We hold harmless the School District from any and all claims, which may result from the activities of our child while so absent from the school premises.

It is understood that the school authorities reserve the right to withdraw the privilege in the event of tardiness, irregular class attendance, low grades, or other conduct of the student that points to the need for closer supervision.
