A very special welcome to all of our 4K students and families! This is our first Appleton Community 4K school newsletter for the 2024-2025 school year; we hope you will find the contents provide you with important information about events taking place in your child's school, as well as helpful information you can use as you support your child's development.

Appleton Community 4K was designed to be a community collaboration with our childcare, preschool, and Head Start partners in the Appleton community. We are currently collaborating with 13 community partner sites and 4 school host sites, to provide high-quality early learning experiences for our 4K students.

In this issue of Appleton Community 4K, Community Connections, you will learn more about the parent survey we completed with our parents last spring and how we are hoping to improve our communication with you to improve our partnership. 
