





Second Step - Social Emotional Curriculum



 - ✓ Black dry erase markers





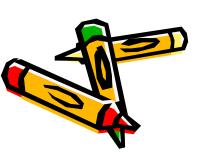
