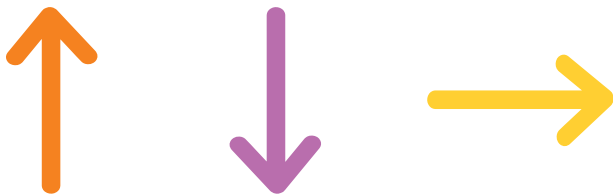

*I can*

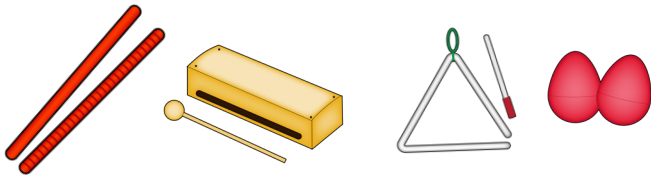
- show high, medium or low sounds.

*I can*

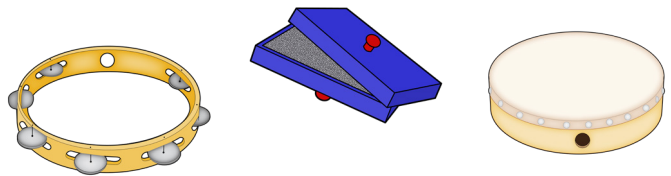
- tell when there's a beat and when there's no beat.
