NWEA Measures of Academic Progress (MAPs)	Reading (K-11) Math (K-11) Language Usage (2-11) Science (4-11)	Aug. 15 - Oct. 6 <i>(screener only)</i> Nov. 30th -Jan 5 April 24 - May 18	Unlimited, typical completion is 60 min. per subject (digital - HS)	Measures academic progress over time for students in 4 content areas; also required for Colorado Accountability through the Unified Improvement Planning process (local)
WorkKeys	Math, reading, workplace documents. (11th & 12 grade)	September 17, 2024	2.5 hours	Focus on Seniors who did not meet state requirements in SAT. Also juniors will be tested as an entire class. Focus is soft / hard skills needed to be successful in workplace skills
ASVAB	Military entrance exam	September 12, 2024	2.5 hours	Open to juniors / seniors interested in military service
Accuplacer	Reading, writing, math (11th & 12th grade)	October	3 hours	Focus on Seniors who did not meet state requirements in SAT. Also juniors will be tested as an entire class
CMAS/CoAlt	Science - 11th grade	April 2, 2025	55-80 min. per session	Measure what students know and can do in Science per the Colorado Academic Standards (state & federal)
PSAT & SAT	Reading/Writing & Math (9-11) (Digitall)	April 16, 2025	2 hrs. 55 min.; plus 30 min. for writing	A college readiness assessment that is a curriculum-based examination that matches well with the education standards in Colorado (state)
Advanced Placement (AP)	Students opting to take the tests (9-12)	May 5-16, 2025	2-3 hours per test	Colleges and universities can grant course credit and placement for scores earned on the test (local)
