# PARCHMENT

- Parchment is the official way to electronically send your transcript to colleges and employers.
- Self-view is available
- Create accounts with the code!





# COLLEGE APPS

You can expect a college application to include the following:

- Official transcripts
- Counselor report
- Test scores (if required)
- List of activities, clubs, extracurriculars
  - Years, leadership roles
- Letters of Recommendation
  - Give at least one week of notice
  - Brag sheet
- Essay(s)
- Possible fee





# COMMON APP

## STANDARDIZED

It is accepted at more than 900 colleges and universities. You fill out one application and it sends to multiple schools.

## APPLY

Schools that require the Common App will link the website from their admissions page.

## EMAIL

Make sure you spell your counselor's email address correctly. We can't complete our part until we receive the notification. You can check your Dashboard to see if we have completed our portion.



# SAT/ACT SCORES

- SAT and ACT scores are printed on your CHS transcript that you request from Parchment; however, some schools will not accept this and you will have to send test scores directly from CollegeBoard.
  - We do not have access to do this or to see your username/password
- Some colleges have waived SAT/SCT requirements, while others require scores
  - Make sure you double check the school's website or call their admissions office

# COLLEGE REPS



- Must sign up on Canvas to attend
  - Posted daily/weekly on Canvas and announcements
- Short meeting with a representative
  - Discuss admissions, college life, popular majors, etc.





# COLLEGE VISITS

- Visit the college's website to schedule a visit
- Use college visits to narrow down your choices and to help make your final decision
- Bring back an official letter and turn it in to the front office
  - You are allowed 2 college visits on school days

# FAFSA - Free Application for Federal Student Aid

- Must be completed to qualify for Federal and State Financial Aid (grants, federal loans, work study)
  - Required/Opt-out
- All families should complete it, regardless of income
- Available October 1
  - Due April 15
  - Colleges can set their own deadlines and some are due as early as February - check with your school
  - Award letters: Jan-March, March-May

  - FAFSA is free

### Senior Year - Semester 1

Tips:

- Work hard to keep your grades up. College admissions counselors review the first semester closely.
- Prepare a cumulative high school resume (list of all school and community service, clubs/sports participation, awards earned, etc.)
- Ask individuals who know you well for letters of recommendation (teachers, counselors, coaches, bosses, etc.) in advance.

### **August**

- ☐ Check with your counselor to verify that you meet all graduation requirements (diploma requirements, graduation pathway, number of credits, etc.) for your final year.
- ☐ Narrow down your post-secondary options

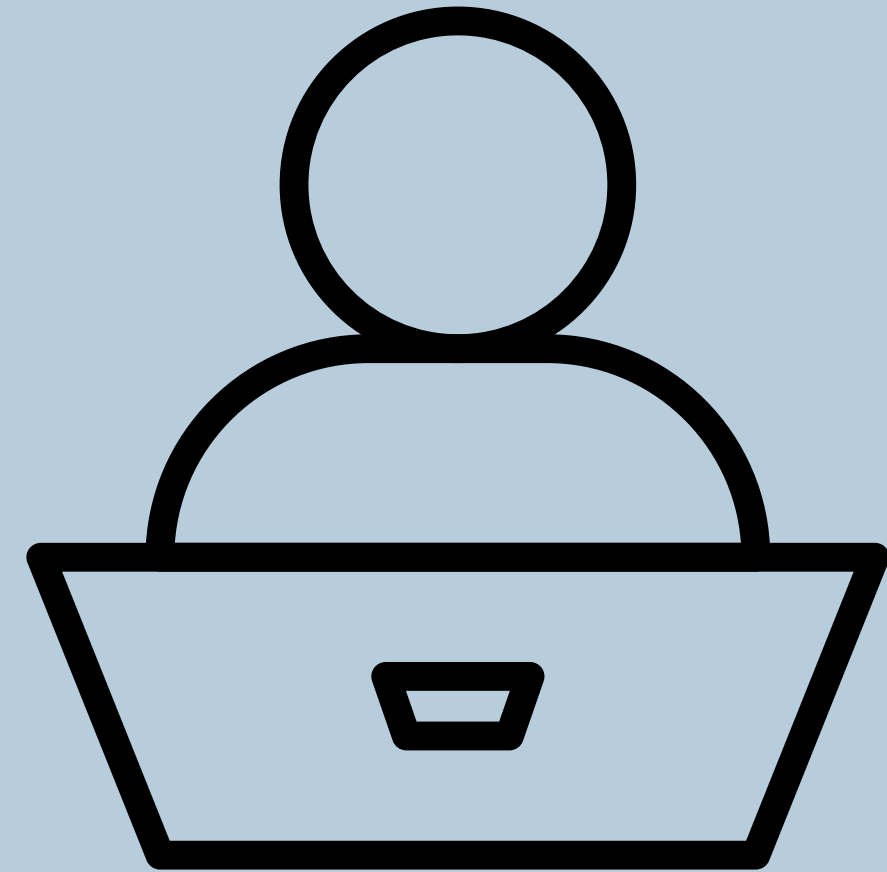
