

Fox Chapel Area School Authority
Business Meeting Minutes
June 24, 2024

A meeting of the Fox Chapel Area School Authority was held in the Administrative Staff Development Room on Monday, June 24, 2024. The meeting was called to order at 8:03 a.m.

Business Items Update

A. Dorseyville Middle School Window Project

Mr. Breitreutz stated that the project is now in the closeout phase. Change order #3 will begin on July 8th and will conclude on July 29th.

B. Hartwood Elementary School HVAC Project

Mr. Thomas reported that he is awaiting the signed contracts from the general contractor, the plumbing contractor, and the HVAC contractor. The HVAC equipment is expected to arrive on site within the next couple of days. The equipment will then be stored in the Dorseyville Middle School parking lot.
