The Pennridge School Board is committed to providing a safe, supportive, and inclusive learning environment that meets the individual needs of all students and prepares them to be well-rounded, lifelong learners with the 21st century skills necessary to succeed on any path they choose. Each new initiative takes into account what is in the best educational interest of the kids; how to provide staff with the tools and training necessary to carry it out; and the most cost effective way to meet these goals.

The worldwide pandemic turned the education world upside down in the early spring of 2020, and presented the staff and students with unprecedented challenges caused by the sudden closure of all schools under Governor Wolf's order. Sound, long-term planning enabled us to be prepared with the technology and infrastructure which enabled the district to quickly pivot and move to an on-line model for delivery of instruction, and additional devices were distributed to the elementary students to help them stay connected with their teachers.

Best Communities for Music Education in 2020

At Pennridge it is important to foster a positive environment for music teaching and learning throughout all levels in our district.

NEWS FROM THE DISTRICT

Graduation

The Class of 2020 graduation was an incredible representation of our students, staff, and community. Although our seniors did not get a traditional graduation, the community rallied around them to make it special. Caps and gowns were delivered personally by teachers and staff, a display of fireworks at 20:20 military time on the night of graduation, a senior dinner where local business donated dinner and dessert, and their graduation ceremony was recorded and broadcast for families to enjoy in the comfort of their own homes. We are so thankful to the Pennridge Community including, Luberto's, Landis Supermarket, The Perk, Café @ The Mill, Hawkeye's, Chiaro's Pizza, J.T. Bankers, Vincent's Pizza, Sapori, and the Hickory Stick for their generosity throughout graduation season.



Fall Academic Plans

In the Fall of 2020, the Pennridge School District provided families with three academic plans for students.

Five Day Return - 45% of our students began the year with a full return to classroom instruction every day with appropriate safety protocols. Masks are required at all times when students and staff are inside our buildings and mask breaks are provided during lunch



and outside when appropriate. Classroom desks are spaced apart with an average distance of 4.5 feet. Students are excited to have the opportunity to experience in classroom learning with their teachers. This academic plan is offered at the elementary and middle schools.

Hybrid - 35% of our students began the year with a hybrid model of two days of classroom instruction, one day of live remote learning, and two days of teacher provided on-line assignments. All students meet remotely with their teacher on Monday or Launch Day with half the students attending in the classroom on Tuesday/Thursday and the other half on Wednesday/Friday. On-line assignments are completed on the days the student is not assigned to class. This academic plan is offered at the high school level and in some elementary grade levels.

Remote Learning - 20% of our students are currently in full-time remote instruction led by a Pennridge teacher that includes both synchronous (live video-instruction) and asynchronous (self-paced) instruction with regularly scheduled virtual office hours where students can receive assistance from a teacher. Remote instruction engages students in virtual learning from home and utilizes Pennridge curriculum to ease any transition back to face-to-face instruction. Students continue to have access to all aspects of being a Pennridge student (activities, sports, clubs, events) and were provided with a school device, if needed. This academic plan was offered to students in grades kindergarten through 12.

The Pennridge School District is dedicated to the safety of our students and staff as well as our mission to care for, protect, and educate our students. The implementation of all three academic plans proved possible with the hard work and collaboration of our administration, staff, and families. Nationally Recognized Unified Sports Program

Special Olympics Pennsylvania has announced that Pennridge High School, a Special Olympics Unified Champion School, is receiving national banner recognition for its efforts to provide inclusive sports and activities for students with and without disabilities. Pennridge High School is receiving this honor as a result of meeting national standards of excellence in the areas of inclusion, advocacy, and respect. Pennridge High School is the first in Bucks County to reach this nationally approved status. We are Pennridge Proud of Mrs. James, Mrs. Fehnel, and the Unified Athletes and Club Members!

Major Goal Areas for 2020-2021

Elementary Literacy Programs

For the 2020-2021 school year, all seven elementary schools have implemented three new literacy programs: Making Meaning; Being a Writer; Words Their Way. These programs provide a balanced literacy approach that stresses reading, writing, and word study.

Continue Curriculum Evaluation and Revision in all Content Areas

The Pennridge School District embarked on a large-scale review and redesign of curricula across all subject areas beginning in the 2018-19 school year. Since that time, all teachers have been provided with professional learning sessions with Internationally Renowned Curriculum Leaders, Dr. Heidi Hayes-Jacobs and Dr. Bena Kallick.

Teachers, Supervisors, Coordinators and the Assistant Superintendents are using this new framework to update the curriculum in each content area. The goal is for all curricular documents to be revised by 2024.

Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion

Pennridge continues the important work in the areas of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI). This summer, approximately 200 staff members completed 1,244 trainings and all teachers received a training on culturally responsive teaching in October.
