2024-2025:

• Arrival and Drop Off:

- Doors open <u>at 8:35 AM to all students</u>. Students will be considered <u>late after 8:50</u>
 <u>AM.</u>
- o If you are dropping off your student in the morning, please pull into the car rider entrance on Washington Avenue any time from 8:25 AM to 8:49 AM, turn right into the playground area. Proceed around the playground area back toward the little circle at the end of the primary wing. Pull to the front of the drop-off line in the little circle.
- Students must exit and enter cars from the right-hand side of the car for their safety.
 Drivers should remain in their cars, at all times. Staff on duty will assist children with instruments or anything else they need.
- o Please exit by using the car rider entrance by which you entered the school property.
- o If you are going to pick up your child on a regular basis, a form must be completed allowing your child to be a car rider on a specific day or days. This form is located on our website under the Families tab. If there is a change to your child's dismissal, please write a note and indicate who will be picking up your child.
- All families were given two signs containing your student's last name. If you misplaced your signs, please notify the office. Please keep this sign in the passenger side windshield during afternoon pick-up. All new families will be receiving two signs containing your student's last name.

Attendance:

Blackboard Connect and Seesaw:

o It is important that you read the announcements and materials sent electronically via Blackboard Connect or Seesaw. Weather announcements and emergencies will be sent via Blackboard Connect. You can store four emails and four phone numbers in this system to receive these notifications.

Buses:

 The buses always run a few minutes late on the first days of school. Please be patient as our drivers learn their new routes.

Clearances and Raptor:

- Please note, to be able to volunteer or to assist on a field trip you must have your clearances on file with the district. The clearances are good for five years from the date of the first clearance.

Kindergarten Busing for Half-Day Programs:

- Kindergarten students will be bused one way to school each day. AM students will be bused to school in the morning with parent pick-up in the middle of the day. PM students will be parent drop-off in the middle of the day, and they will ride the bus home at the end of the day.
- Students participating in the full-day kindergarten program will be bused both ways.

Meet and Greet for Students and Parents in Grades K-5:

 Thursday, August 22, 2024, 2:30-3:30 PM. This event gives students and parents an opportunity to have a "sneak-peak" at their new classroom and to meet their new teacher.

Parent Portal:

It is imperative that each parent/guardian log into the Parent Portal and update the information on your child for the new year. The information is not updated until you press <u>submit</u> and receive a confirmation. The Tylenol and antacid releases, Blackboard Connect phone numbers, Media Authorization, Computer User Agreement, etc. are all on this site. These fields must be updated annually.

To establish a positive relationship with our local police department, this program has been developed to bring police into our schools to establish positive connections with our students and staff.
