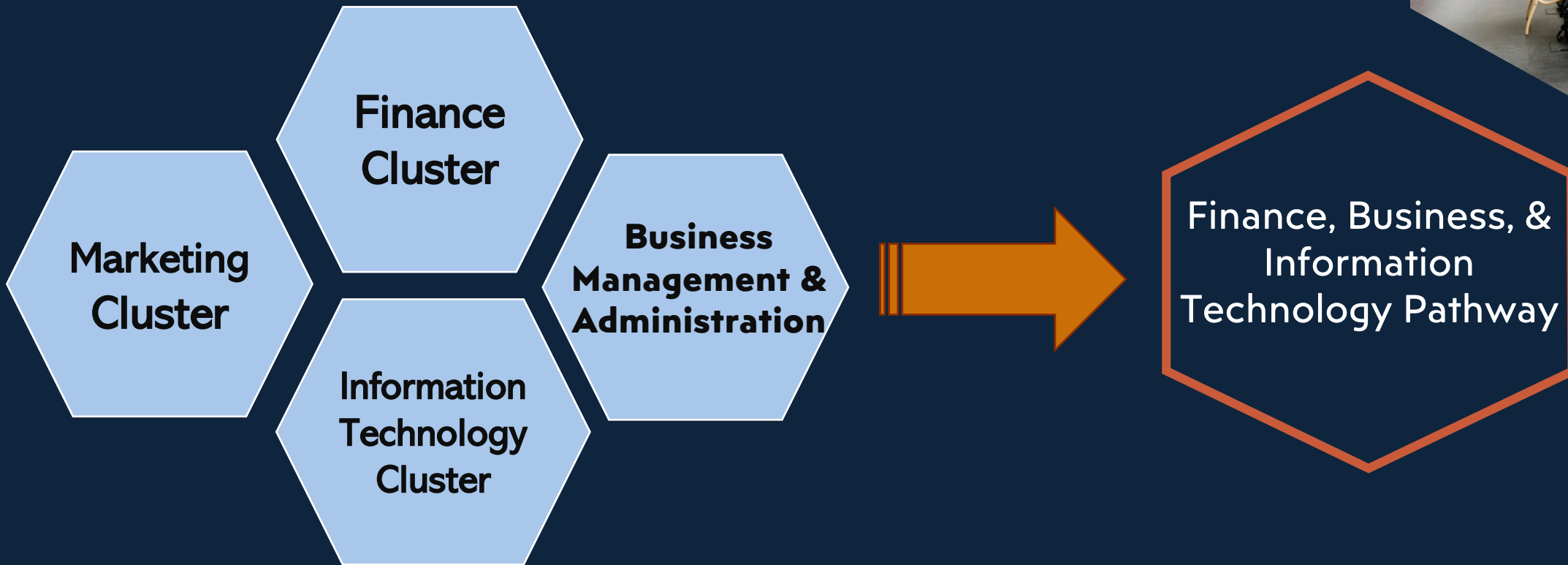

Career Experiences

Guest Speakers

Professionals in the workplace come and talk about their career field and industry. A great way to introduce you lots of career opportunities.

Site Tours

Field trips to offices, showrooms, factories, laboratories, and other places of business. A chance to see what a possible workplace looks like in a certain career field.

Job Shadowing

Observation of one or more professional in the workplace for an extended period time. Learn daily routines and responsibilities.

Mentorship

An immersive hands-on experience with a selected employer. Typically, 20-hours in length. You can expect to complete tasks, attend meetings, assist in assembling components and much more!

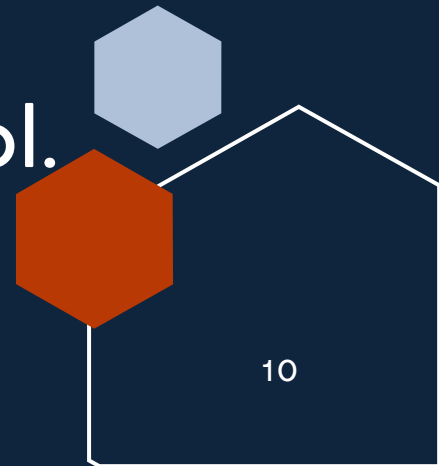
