ACADEMIC INFORMATION AND SCHOOL ORGANIZATION

Wimberley High School is accredited by the Texas Education Agency. The school year consists of two eighteen-week semester grading periods with an alternating A/B block schedule. Classes are 90 minutes in length. Students can earn up to eight credits per year.

Wimberley High School students consistently score well above the State & National average on AP Exams. AP courses offered are Biology, Calculus AB, Chemistry, English Language & Composition, English Literature & Composition, Physics B1, U.S. History, World History, U.S. Government, and Environmental Science. Dual Credit courses are also offered, which include; Austin Community College English Composition I & II, British Literature I & II, U.S. Government, Economics, U.S. History I & II, Introduction to Psychology, and Introduction to Sociology. UT OnRamps College Algebra and Statistics Dual Enrollment is also an option for students.

Students are ranked based on their weighted 4.0 GPA with extra points given to Honors, AP, and Dual Credit/Dual Enrollment.
