RE: Lancer Stadium Seating Protocol and Game Reminders

The following information is for seating arrangements and expectations at Lancer Stadium for the 2024 football season.

To keep all patrons safe and enjoy the football games, we are sending out updates for our student spectators that will be enforced at our home football games.

- Please do not let your child bring equipment to the game (footballs, scooters, skateboards, bikes, etc). Any items that make their way to the game will be confiscated at the event. A parent/guardian will need to pick these up from the High School the following week.
- Spectators are not allowed to bring backpacks into the stadium at any time.
- Students will be asked to sit in a designated area according to their grade.
  - K-3rd grade students must sit with the adult who brought them to the game.
  - 4th-8th grade students must sit in the south bleachers of the stadium - or with the adult that brought them to the game.
  - 9-12th grade students must sit in the south portion of the main grandstand - or with the adult who brought them to the game.
- Unless a special event/recognition is taking place, students or anyone other than event personnel are not allowed on the track or game field.
- Individuals are not allowed to walk on the track to get from either side of Lancer Stadium.
- The north-end zone of Lancer Stadium is a great seating area for families with young children. We understand the fun of sitting with friends and offering a family-friendly atmosphere. With this, we ask for parent support to keep children close to you throughout the event.
