FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS & RESOURCES

What is the Student Fundraiser?

The Student Fundraiser is our annual student-led school fundraiser that highlights and supports our vibrant community. In 2024, each student is championed to "Share Your Love for SMA" by raising \$200 through their extended network of friends and family to contribute to the school-wide goal of \$100,000. The event is a learning opportunity for students; teaching them about the importance of philanthropy, while giving them on the ground experience with fundraising. The funds raised through the Student Fundraiser support the entire SMA community, benefiting academics, extra-curricular activities, tuition assistance, and more.

When is the Student Fundraiser?

Monday, September 30 through Thursday, October 17, 2024.

Who should you ask for donations?

The student fundraiser is an opportunity for students to engage with their communities, including neighbors, extended family members, church friends, and their parents' co-workers. Students are encouraged to share their personal St. Mary's story and educate their community on the school's special impact on young women. The student fundraiser is about deepening the web of support for SMA.

Can people make donations online?

Yes! Each student is required to make a fundraising page, which can be shared to social media, via email, or texted. Donating online is a quick and easy alternative to writing a check. Information about how to set up a page can be found on the Student Fundraiser Resources Page.

Is donating online the only way to support SMA?

Not at all! Donations can be made via your fundraising page, by cash, or check. Cash or check donations that you have raised can be left in the donation box in the front office. Be sure to fill out a donation envelope with the information requested for the donation to count towards your total. Envelopes are in the front office next to the donut trophy.

What tools are there to help you fundraise?

- SMAporters! These are people who want to donate to the student fundraiser but don't have a student to donate to. Fill out the "request a SMAporter form on the Resources Page for more information.

What is the Spirit Walk?

This low-intensity and high-fun walk is three-miles long and begins at SMA. It loops around the Willamette River along Waterfront Park, across the Steel Bridge, down the Eastbank Esplanade, and then across the Hawthorne Bridge and back to the school.

With whom do I walk?

Each TA walks together! You will be dismissed by TA (seniors first!) and will walk with your class. All students are required to turn in a permission slip to their TA in order to participate.

What if I can't participate in the walk? (injury, illness, physical limitation, etc.)

If you cannot participate in the walk, you can still participate in the fundraiser (and carnival day!) by collecting donations and meeting your personal fundraising goal of \$200. You are still eligible to win all of the prizes and participate in all of the fun. The day of the walk you will be assigned a task at SMA to assist with the production of the event or cheer on your fellow students.

STEPS TO START FUNDRAISING



CREATE your online fundraising page. This takes less than a minute and can make a huge impact in achieving your fundraising goal!



COMPILE a list of contacts. Use the contact list sheet and ask template as a place to brainstorm. Ask your parents for contacts and be sure to ask if their employer will match their gift. Employer gift matching will double the amount you earn!



CONTACT your extended network of friends and family with personalized emails, letters, calls, and videos! Just think, if you ask 20 people for \$10 you will have made your goal!



BE SOCIAL! Share your online fundraising page and love of SMA on social media. Also, look for fun student fundraiser posts on SMA social media and share them to help promote the event!



SHOW YOUR APPRECIATION as money comes in and be sure to send thank you notes! Notecards are available in the front office.



ASK FOR TIPS! If you are unsure of where to start, who to ask, or need some new ideas on how to fundraise, we are here to help! Ask your TA and classmates for their suggestions about how they fundraise, or reach out to Liz Olufson, to get contact information for people who want to donate to you!
