Thank you for your patience and cooperation during Morning Drop Off. Please note, we make every effort to keep Stillwater Road open to through traffic. Our security staff may ask you to briefly pull into the church parking lot if necessary.

Attendance: If your child will be absent for either in person learning or remote learning, please call the attendance line at **973-383-3227.** It is imperative that you report your child absent prior to the start of the school day if they are unable to participate in remote learning due to illness or other reason. Those students who are not called in absent will be expected to complete their remote learning assignments. A failure to do so will be reflected in their marking period grades.

If your child is absent from their in person cohort, they will be marked absent. If they are able to complete work remotely, the work will be considered as their make up work for the day but the absence will still be marked.

PRESCHOOL NEWS:

Do you know what the 3R's are? Ask any preschooler and they will tell you. We just completed our study of Reduce, Reuse and Recycle. They know all of the items that need to be recycled and have been practicing ways to reuse items that they would normally throw out. Many

preschoolers have also asked their parents if they could switch from taking baths to taking showers in an effort to conserve water. The children enjoyed working at learning centers which involved sorting items into the proper bins, such as plastic, glass etc., and also identifying things that would make the Earth happy versus those that would make the Earth sad.


