# **PRESCHOOL NEWS**:

Preschool students just began a new study about Recycling. The children have become curious about the different types of recycling bins they see in our classrooms and throughout our school. During this study, children will learn about the three R's: Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle. They will have the opportunity to learn what can be recycled and how we can reuse objects. We will be developing thinking skills to observe, investigate, ask questions, solve problems, make predictions, and test our ideas. Talk with your child about trash and garbage. Help raise your child's awareness of the kinds of trash and garbage your family creates each day. If you dispose of your trash at a dump or landfill, take your child along to see where the trash goes. If you recycle at home, help your child take responsibility for sorting items into your family's recycling bins. When you are outside with your child and you notice a piece of trash on the ground, point it out and talk about it. For example, say, "I wonder why someone dropped that candy wrapper on the ground. Is it supposed to be there? Is there a better place to put it?"

The preschoolers are also learning about the life cycle of butterflies. The children have been observing caterpillars in our classrooms, which have now all formed their cocoons. We can't wait to see the butterflies emerge soon! We'll have a fun day releasing them in our school garden!



# FOURTH GRADE ELA NEWS:

The year is winding down, but in Fourth Grade ELA we are not! We just started our final novel, *Number the Stars.* The students are excited to find out how our characters are navigating through this difficult historical setting. It has been interesting to see how fact and fiction come together to create this thrilling novel. We will soon begin our opinion writing unit to finish out this school year. Our Fourth Grade learners are definitely keeping busy this spring!

### **FIFTH GRADE NEWS**:

This year 5th-grade students went on a field trip to Quiet Valley Living Historical Farm in Stroudsburg, Pennsylvania. Quiet Valley Living Historical Farm is a living history museum preserving 19th-century heritage. This trip is on a 114-acre farm full of beautiful pastures, woodlands, and streams. Quiet Valley hosts all the farm animals typically found in the 1800s, such as rabbits, chickens, ducks, cows, pigs, etc. The buildings include an 1850s bank barn, the original farmhouse, a cabin, spring house, ice house, smokehouse, dry house, and other smaller barns. The students were thrilled to have hands-on experience with animals, tools, and other life experiences from colonial times.

### THE NEWTON SHARKS SWIM TEAM IS LOOKING FORWARD TO SWIMMING IN THE SUMMER OF 2022!

In our 44th year, the Newton Pool, our home, is beautifully repaired and is up and running and ready for our return!

Since its inaugural year in 1976, The Newton Sharks Swim Team has been a member of the Wallkill Valley Swim Conference, a summer recreational program committed to the development of the enjoyment of swimming.

The Newton Sharks was the only pool team in the WVSC until 2004. Now, we are the only *outdoor* pool team in the league.

The Newton Sharks range in age from 5 to 18 and hail from many towns and communities in Sussex County, New Jersey - Newton, Andover, Green, Sparta, Stillwater, Stanhope, Lafayette, Sussex, Wantage - among others.

Our team unofficially serves as a feeder program to the state qualifying Newton Lenape Valley High School team coached by Jess Jacobellis, who began her own swim career at the age of four with the Lake Tranquility Thunderbolts, also a WVSC team.

Over the course of the average season, our Sharks compete in 8 meets – both pools and lakes – and compete in both an invitational and championship all during the month of July. It's endless swimming and fun, so much so that it feels like it's not a summer to our swimmers and their families, without The Newton Sharks!
