# **PRESCHOOL NEWS**:

Our preschoolers are excited to be back at school after spring break! The classes have begun (or are about to begin) a new study on "Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle" where we will learn all about where our trash goes and ways that we can help to improve the environment around us. We are learning what items can be recycled and other ways to decrease waste and pollution. The students are all eager to share the ways that we can help the Earth, so be sure to ask them about it!

# **ART NEWS**:

Our young artists have been creating original designs of El Sol, The Sun, in celebration of Cinco di Mayo. Students have been experimenting with techniques in painting, metal tooling, drawing and weaving. Our 3rd graders are currently exploring symmetry in design with the Mexican folk art of paper cutting, Papel Picado. Papel Picado literally means 'punched' or 'perforated' paper. This traditional cut paper folk art is found throughout Mexico and the former colonies of Spain as well as in the folk traditions of many other countries.

Students have been preparing for this year's Spring Concert: Music is a Treat! The concert will be held on Tuesday, May 3rd at 7:00 pm at Stillwater School. ### THE NEWTON SHARKS SWIM TEAM IS LOOKING FORWARD TO SWIMMING IN THE SUMMER OF 2022!

In our 44th year, the Newton Pool, our home, is beautifully repaired and is up and running and ready for our return!

Since its inaugural year in 1976, The Newton Sharks Swim Team has been a member of the Wallkill Valley Swim Conference, a summer recreational program committed to the development of the enjoyment of swimming.

The Newton Sharks was the only pool team in the WVSC until 2004. Now, we are the only *outdoor* pool team in the league.

The Newton Sharks range in age from 5 to 18 and hail from many towns and communities in Sussex County, New Jersey - Newton, Andover, Green, Sparta, Stillwater, Stanhope, Lafayette, Sussex, Wantage - among others.

Our team unofficially serves as a feeder program to the state qualifying Newton Lenape Valley High School team coached by Jess Jacobellis, who began her own swim career at the age of four with the Lake Tranquility Thunderbolts, also a WVSC team.

Over the course of the average season, our Sharks compete in 8 meets – both pools and lakes – and compete in both an invitational and championship all during the month of July. It's endless swimming and fun, so much so that it feels like it's not a summer to our swimmers and their families, without The Newton Sharks!
