PRESCHOOL NEWS:

The Preschool students are excited to begin a study about Pets! The children have become curious about the different types of pets they see, what pets need, how pets make us feel, and the kinds of jobs that involve working with pets. We think it will be engaging and fun! We always welcome materials from home for the children to explore, such as different plastic or stuffed toy pets and books or pictures related to pets. At home, you can take notice of pets in our community. Be on the lookout for pets at dog parks, on walks, in cars, and in homes. Talk about the kinds of animals you and your child like and how pets make us feel. If you have pets at home you can email us photos or make video recordings of your children interacting with and helping care for the pet. We will share these in class on the Active Board!







SECOND GRADE NEWS:

What do you like better, summer or winter? What is your favorite book? Who are your favorite characters? Well, ask a second grader because they will tell you their **opinion!** Second graders are learning how to write opinion pieces while introducing a topic, providing supporting reasons, and a closing. We are having fun listening to the different opinions of our classmates!

THIRD GRADE FAMILY MATH NEWS:

Families taking the <u>3rd grade Family Math Class</u> enjoyed the M&M and Create a Puzzle activity using geometric word vocabulary. Warm-up activities included a Birthday graph, Box Math, and Bean Salad word problems. Congratulations to Ayla Ponce and her mother Alex who won the estimation jar of pretzels. We will meet again on Tuesday evening of next week.

FIFTH GRADE NEWS:

This week, 5th-grade students have begun their nonfiction reading and writing units. They are learning to navigate nonfiction texts. They are discovering the importance of text features and various nonfiction text structures in order to strengthen their nonfiction reading skills. In writing, students will choose a topic to research for the purpose of creating their own minibooks.

In Social Studies, students are continuing to learn about the Revolutionary War. They have learned about the causes of the American Revolution. Next, they will explore the different battles and learn about the formation of the new American government.

SIXTH GRADE NEWS:

The 6th graders are currently learning about Ancient Greece. Two of the most important city states are Athens and Sparta. Students are studying how Spartans lived a war-like existence and both men and women carried the power. Spartans had very little time for art and music. They focused solely on their military and keeping Sparta a strong place to live. Ancient Athens, however, was a place of art and music and theater! Even though they had more free time to hang out in the "agora", an open-air marketplace, the women had no rights and weren't really permitted anywhere. Students chose either Athens or Sparta to further their research and made beautiful brochures filled with maps, symbols and some even have the Greek alphabet along with other cool information! If you get a chance, take a walk down to the Mrs. Steffens bulletin board to check them out!

SIXTH GRADE YEARBOOK NEWS:

The 6th-grade students have all received a biography form to fill out via Google Docs. Many students have already turned them in! 
