#### **Preschool News:**

Preschool students are wrapping up the Tree Study and are ready to begin investigating our next study about Lights! Our first focus question in the study is, "What kind of lights are around us?" We will be investigating natural vs. artificial light, shadows, whether objects are translucent, transparent, or opaque, and what it means to reflect or refract light! You might want to have some flashlights on hand to continue these investigations at home! The Light Study is perfectly timed with the Holiday Season. Be sure you take your little learner to discover all holiday lights in the Stillwater community!

#### **Preschool Gross Motor Class News:**

Phew! We have been moving so much in our Preschool Gross Motor class. The students have been practicing all their movement skills these past couple of months. They are running, hopping, skipping, galloping, marching, and learning how to move in an open space. Our classes are full of games, actions, and dancing. The preschoolers enjoy playing outside as much as possible, so please pack warm coats, hats, and mittens.

#### **Second Grade News:**

What an exciting few weeks we have had in Second Grade! Students have been working hard in both Reading and Writing over the last several weeks and it was time to celebrate their accomplishments! Children became non-fiction experts in Reading and shared their gift of knowledge with others by creating and presenting an Expert Museum! The students did such a wonderful job reading several books on one topic and putting together the information they learned to "grow knowledge!" In Writing, Second Graders have become accomplished narrative writers and chose one small moment story to publish and share with others. We couldn't be more proud of our accomplishments!



Students have been exploring the science of weathering and erosion to understand how Earth's surface changes. Students learned about different types of rock by taking a crayon through the rock cycle. Along the journey, the "rock" experienced many natural forces such as wind and water that caused the crayon rock to change significantly. We will continue our exploration of weathering and erosion through several hands-on activities in the upcoming weeks.

#### **Music News:**

Music News: Happy Holidays! This year's Winter Concert will be taking place on Thursday, December 9th (snow date: Tuesday, December 14th). To help with keeping students and families healthy, the schedule will look different this year, but allow for in-person performances! The second grade will be singing at 1:30 and the fourth grade will perform at 2:10. Sixth grade, Advanced Band and Select Choir will perform in the evening beginning at 7:00 pm. Guests are limited to two adults and siblings for each student performing. Concerts will also be recorded for families and friends to watch at a later date. All performances will take place in the Stillwater gym. An additional notice with information has been sent home with students involved. A form for recording permission has also been sent home with students. Please return this form if you do not wish for your child to be recorded. We hope to see you there to start off the holiday season!

#### **Fifth Grade News:**

During the Writing Workshop, students have been learning all the components of an Opinion Essay. Together through shared writing, classes drafted an essay on a topic they voted for: Christmas is the best holiday. Fifth graders are learning that an opinion essay has a strong claim in the introduction, three reasons to support their claim for the body paragraphs, and a concluding paragraph to summarize the essay. Next, they will be composing an essay independently on a topic of their choice!

In math, we have been working on the multiplication of decimals to hundredths using the standard algorithm. Students have learned to use patterns to place the decimal point when a decimal is multiplied by a power of 10. They will apply this understanding of place value to estimate decimal products to check their work. Keep practicing multiplication facts to improve fact fluency and accuracy when multiplying numbers with decimals.





### **Sixth Grade Yearbook News:**

One of our Stillwater Yearbook traditions is to have each 6th-grade student write a small biography for the yearbook. The 6th-grade students will have their current school picture, a baby photo and a biography in the yearbook. The students will be receiving a biography form to fill out in school in the next few weeks. Please remind them to complete it once it is received. We are also asking all 6th-grade
