# **PRESCHOOL NEWS:**

As we study trees, we will investigate how trees grow, the parts of a tree, and why we need trees. This unit will include hands-on investigations, literacy, math, the arts, and technology to explore the topic in depth.

First grade has been hard at work in Writers Workshop. The students began their unit on how-to writing by working together to write a book on how to carve a pumpkin. #### **MUSIC NEWS:**

Happy Holidays! This year's Winter Concert will be taking place on Thursday, December 9th (snow date: Tuesday, December 14th). To help with keeping students and families healthy, the schedule will look different this year, but allow for in-person performances! The second grade will be singing at 1:30 and the fourth grade will perform at 2:10. Sixth grade, Advanced Band and Select Choir will perform in the evening beginning at 7:00 pm. Guests are limited to two adults and siblings for each student performing. Concerts will also be recorded for families and friends to watch at a later date. #### **FIFTH GRADE NEWS:**

Fifth Graders wrapped up their Personal Narratives this week and finished working on drafting a strong ending, revising to make their writing more clear and editing for spelling, grammar and punctuation. We worked through the Writing Process with the goal for 5th graders to publish 1-2 pages for their finished narratives. In math, students are working on multiplication of 2-digit by 2-digit numbers and 3-digit by 2-digit numbers. To improve their multiplication fact fluency, they can log in to their Freckle account and choose Fact Practice. The ability to recall basic facts quickly and accurately will help them with larger multiplication problems, including multiplying decimals.







#### **NOVEMBER RECYCLING NEWS:**

America Recycles Day-November 15th

Our student recycling group, *The Cafeteria Connection*, will kick-off America Recycles Day by launching our next school and community recycling initiative. We have partnered with the TREX decking company and have received recycling bins for the collection of plastic film, something we have not been able to recycle here at school in the past. The bins are located in the vestibule, the Makerspace and the Staff Room.

Information will be shared with students and families so that we may all take part in another effort to reduce waste that travels to landfills! As part of this program, we are entered into a contest where the school that recycles the most will receive a garden bench made of plastic! The contest will run until April, so we will be collecting all year! Please share the news with friends and neighbors in the community - we welcome all recyclers! #### **GARDEN NEWS: WE'RE GROWING GARLIC!**

Last week the Green Thumbs Garden Club welcomed a special visitor to our school garden. Mr. Dennis DeGroat, a Stillwater Community member, Board of Education member and former teacher met with the student group to teach them how to plant and grow garlic.

We learned about the different types of garlic and how to prepare the garden bed for planting. He also showed the students how to prepare a garlic bulb for oven roasting with olive oil - yummy for garlic bread! More than 30 cloves of garlic were planted and covered with soil and straw for the winter months. Next July, the crop will be harvested, hung in bunches to dry, and shared with staff and students in the fall.

A very special thank you to Mr. DeGroat for volunteering to meet with us and for sharing his garlic and garden expertise!







#### **GARDEN NEWS: BUTTERFLIES**


Over the past two weeks, 10 monarch butterflies have been released from the 1st grade classrooms! The caterpillars were brought inside in September, and the students witnessed the life cycle of the butterfly in action with their teachers and classmates. Each day, they witnessed this amazing transformation, ending with beautiful butterflies. After successfully releasing them into our pollinator garden, children have observed that the butterflies continue to spend time here at Stillwater School! We expect them to begin their journey south when the weather begins to cool.



### **PHYS ED NEWS:**

Phys Ed classes have been off to a great start this year. We have a new addition to our Gymnasium this year - Lu Interactive Playground. Through the NY Jets and NJ Department of Agriculture, we received a grant last year and were able to purchase an interactive projector. We are the first ones in the state of New Jersey to have this system. The students have been enjoying playing all the games on it. Also this year we have done a cooperative games unit, soccer unit, four square, and most recently fun Halloween Stations. We also began a mileage club this year. Students complete laps during phys ed class to complete a card. Once their card is completed they have completed 5 miles and they get to hang their card on our wall and also receive a special foot token they can put on their shoe or a keychain. 


# GIRLS SCOUTS OF NORTHERN NEW JERSEY INFORMATION:


