HALLOWEEN GUIDELINES:

THIRD GRADE NEWS:

In science, third graders recently finished their first unit which focused on what science is, what scientists do, and the scientific method. Students completed several experiments...one was on buoyancy to see if different cookies would float in milk. Do you think the cookies floated or sank? Try it at home to find out! In math, students have been working extremely hard sharpening key math skills such as place value, addition and subtraction of multi-digit numbers, and they are currently working on becoming rounding masters! They are doing phenomenal! All third graders are excited to have field trips back this year! We are looking forward to our field trip this Friday, 10/22, at Tranquility Farms!

PE NEWS:

This week the 5th graders have been going over to Kittatinny Regional High School pool for our Water Safety Program (Drown Proofing Program). This is a great program where the student can learn a variety of new skills that will keep them safe and others safe around the water. In this program, the students learned and practiced different swimming strokes as well as survival skills in the water. The 5th grade also learned safe ways to rescue someone by using reach or throwing assists. At the end of each lesson, the students were able to have some time to participate in different water games and activities. The students had a fantastic time and the teachers saw improvement in each one of the students' skills and abilities. MINDFULNESS NEWS:

Our new Mindfulness program is off to a great start! Each homeroom class meets with Mrs. Piazza every other week to learn about the meaning of Mindfulness and how a daily practice can create a calmer lifestyle. Studies have proven Mindfulness to be effective in reducing stress and anxiety while building self-esteem. Topics in Awareness, Attention and the 5 Scenes have been discussed as students explored various self-management techniques. Mindfulness can be practiced in any place or time of the day. Encourage your child to continue their Mindfulness practice at home, 5 mins a day goes a long way!



SPEECH NEWS:

This month, we've been learning about our body parts and senses: sight, smell, touch, hearing, and taste. We've also learned about ourselves including our likes, dislikes, and what makes us unique!

Learning "All About Me" provides many great opportunities for language. Consider talking about your child's emotions, senses, and body parts. Work together to learn about each other, finding out what your child loves the most. This theme also provides a great context for learning about others! Encourage your child to think about others. Do all children think the same way or have the same interests? How is your child similar or different from his/her classmates? Think of questions your child can ask others to learn more about them!

OCTOBER RECYCLING NEWS:

Our student group, *The Cafeteria Connection*, sponsored our first recycling contest in the cafeteria! The contest involved counting bags of recycled milk cartons, juice boxes and plastic bottles from each lunch period for this whole week. By the middle of the week, the contest was even - it seems that the students are doing a great job remembering what gets recycled and where! The winning lunch period will be announced next week. 


SUSSEX COUNTY YMCA HAS SOME WONDERFUL PROGRAM OFFERINGS COMING UP:




