KINDERGARTEN NEWS:

The kindergarten classes are getting settled into the new school year! We have been establishing classroom routines and spending a lot of time becoming familiar with the Chromebooks. They know how to log in and find their Google classrooms. They also know how to go to useful websites like RAZ-Kids, Starfall and ABCya. The children also began sharing what makes their families and friends so special and they have completed some projects that show how unique and special they are. This week the kindergarten classes began learning about colors and the four seasons. The kindergarten teachers enjoyed seeing you at Back to School Night and wish everyone a wonderful school year!

FIRST GRADE NEWS:

First grade is becoming familiar with classroom routines. We really enjoy seeing our friends and being back in school. Right now the students are enjoying our unit on butterflies and are observing the life cycle of the butterfly in our school garden. We recently found caterpillars in the garden and are looking forward to observing them change into butterflies!











SECOND GRADE NEWS:

Second-grade readers are beginning to grow like beanstalks. Previewing a book, deciding HOW a book wants to be read, and scooping words into phrases are some of the strategies they have been working on to improve their skills. Ask a Second Grader what reading stamina means. They will be excited to tell you that each day they are reading for a longer period of time, even when their minds and bodies want to stop! We can't wait to see how much they grow as readers this year! The sky's the limit!

FIFTH GRADE NEWS:

Fifth graders are working on their first writing unit developing Personal Narratives. These are stories about true events that really happened. We have started generating seed ideas and will be working to stretch them into stories with a beginning, middle and end. We are sharing memories, creating story maps, and making lists to get our ideas flowing. Students will work through the writing process and eventually publish a piece of writing of their choice!

During Math Workshop, students are beginning unit one with understanding patterns with exponents and powers of 10. They have learned that the exponent is the number that tells us how many times a base number is used as a factor. They will also begin working with decimals to thousandths. They will use their understanding of place value to read and write decimals using words, standard form, and expanded form with fractions. Lastly, they will compare and round decimals using the place value system.

We are having a great time learning and growing in the 5th Grade!


