FIFTH GRADE NEWS

5th Grade Math

The fifth graders are hard at work learning about fractions. There is a lot of important vocabulary that's associated with fractions. The crucial concept is what a fraction means and being able to find equivalent fractions by either using multiplication or division. Students learned that it's necessary to find equivalent fractions with a least common multiple with adding and subtracting fractions and mixed numbers. They used these skills to rename mixed numbers when subtracting and how to simplify their answers. Our next topic with fractions will be to multiply and then divide.

NEWS FROM MRS. HOON'S CLASS

In writing workshop, students in fifth grade are currently working on research essays for Black History Month. They are reading, researching, taking notes, and will compose essays to share with their classmates. Students learned about plagiarism and how to take notes, summarize and credit sources for information correctly in their writing.

In reading, we are in the middle of a novel study on Maniac Magee. Jerry Spinelli wrote this book about the main character Jeffrey "Maniac" Magee who becomes an orphan boy looking for a home during a time of segregation. Throughout the story, students learn about the struggles Maniac goes through; not having a home, not fitting in on either side of town, and the search for finding a loving family and home. They are hooked into the story, waiting to see what happens to Maniac and if he will find the family and home he deserves. We have analyzed characters, symbolism, history and will discuss themes at the end of the novel.

SIXTH GRADE NEWS:

Math students in sixth grade have been learning about ratios. Understanding that ratios are relationships between quantities that can compare a part to a part or a part to a whole, students learned having similar terms is necessary to compare these relationships. Special ratios called rates and unit rates were used with conversion tables to convert between customary and metric units of

measure. We will expand upon ratios and rates by learning about percentages in the next few weeks and then will move forward into Geometry and Statistical Analysis as the school year progresses. Problem-solving will continue to be a focus. Students have been making great progress using the mathematical practice standards to help them!




