The music classes have been learning how to play new instruments, including boomwhackers, egg shakers, handbells and handchimes, as well as flute, clarinet, trumpet, trombone and





## **NEWS FROM MAKERSPACE**

Happy HallowSTEAM from the Makerspace!

Students enjoyed their visits to the Makerspace with some fun with HallowSTEAM challenges!

- In Kindergarten and 1st grade, children enjoyed the story of *Spookley the Square Pumpkin* and then designed their own shaped pumpkins with pipe cleaners and beads.
- 2nd graders enjoyed making spiderwebs! After viewing some videos of unusual spiders and learning about these creatures, students used pipe cleaners to create a web design similar to those found in the video. Many students enjoyed creating a scary spider to add to their web!
- 3rd and 4th grade explored a STEAM design challenge related to designing their own candy bag! After viewing a video on the history of candy, the engineers began to sketch their prototypes and write a materials list. Construction of the bags will continue next week!
- In 5th and 6th grade, students will be constructing "bone bridges" and competing for the strongest or longest bridge design! Students are also continuing their 3-Printer Design Challenges - to create a project that includes their name and creative elements and to design a haunted house to print!

All of the students enjoyed using the Engineering Design Process in the Makerspace to celebrate HallowSTEAM with their friends! (See the pictures below!)







## **PHYSICAL EDUCATION NEWS**
