The Stillwater Township Board of Education met on November 6, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. in the Stillwater School Library for a Committee of the Whole Board of Education Meeting.

The meeting was called to order by Krista Galante, President, at 7:00 p.m. In accordance with the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Law, the time, date and location of this meeting was provided to the New Jersey Herald & Star Ledger on January 10, 2023. Notices were posted in the Stillwater School, Town Hall, Stillwater Post Office, Swartswood Post Office and the Stillwater School Website.

BOARD BUSINESS

- 2. Motion made by Mrs. Frey, second by Mrs. Valeich, to approve the September 30, 2023 Board Secretary's and Treasurer's Reports which balanced in the amount of \$3,639,806.34 pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-16.10(c)3, we certify that as of September 30, 2023 after review of the secretary's monthly financial report (appropriations section) and upon consultation with the appropriate district officials, to the best of our knowledge no major account or fund has been over-expended in violation of N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-16.10(c)4, and that sufficient funds are available to meet the district's financial obligations for the remainder of the fiscal year.
