  - When am I at my best? My worst?
  - What truly matters most to me?
  - What motivates me? What challenges me?
  - Where do I feel comfortable? Uncomfortable?
  - When do I feel purposeful?
  - What gifts do I have to give?

#### What Does a "Good" College List Look Like?

- Represents Student's VALUES
- Appropriate Size (8-12 is the sweet spot)
- Has at least 2-3 'slam dunk' schools (admit and \$)
- No more than a third are 'reach' schools
- *Every* school meets student's priorities (7 Ps)
- *Every* school will make student happy
- Represents a healthy collaboration between students, parents, and college counselor.
- Accounts for family's financial situation

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# Student's General Timeline

#### September

- Fall Check-In with College Counselor
- Continue Building College List
- Meet with Admissions Reps @ DePaul Prep
- Attack the Common App
- Draft Personal Statement/College Specific Essays
- Potentially Take Standardized Tests\*
- Complete Teacher LoR Process (Advisory)
- Explore <u>Scholarship Options</u>



# **Student's General Timeline**

#### October

- CSS Profile Available October 1; FAFSA is TBD
- Settle On Early College List
- Finishing Touches on Essay(s)
- Complete the Early App (EA/ED) Process
  - October 15 deadline for *some* colleges
- Take Standardized Tests SAT = Oct 2 (DePaul Prep)
- Submit Official Test Scores\*
- Continue to Meet Admissions Reps @ DePaul Prep
- Continue to Explore Scholarship Options

# Student's General Timeline November

- Submit Applications for Nov I and I5 for Early Action and Early Decision Deadlines
- Re-Evaluate College List
  - Build Potential Plan for Regular Decision Apps
- Reach Out to Reps/Follow up Apps
  SRAR (UIUC, Clemson, etc)
- Continue Exploring Scholarship Options
- Continue to Send Official Test Scores\*

- How comfortable are you with your list?
- Is your list financially appropriate?

- Do you have plans to meet with College Reps?
- How can we support you?
- Is your **Application** 
  - **Tracker** up to date?

## **Test Optional...What's the Deal?**

- **2021**: 45% of Comm App Applicants used scores Under 10% of DCP Seniors submitted scores
- **2022**: 1,830+ Test Optional Institutions 10 total DCP Seniors submitted scores (6%)
- **2023:** 1,830+ Remained Test-Optional, 77 Test Free 26 total Seniors used scores in the app process (15%)
- **2024:** 2000+ Test Optional Institutions, 80 Test Free 84 Seniors used scores for some/all (38%)
- **2025:** 2070 Test Optional or Test Free Institutions

## **Test Optional Trends**

- Large Publics potential bend back to testing?
- Southern Schools are already there
- Many Uber Selectives and Smaller Liberal Arts will likely never go back
- Selective Schools got WAY more selective (and still admitted higher % of Testers vs T.O.)
- *Drastic* demographic differences

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### **Student Responsibilities**

- Organize and Manage Maia/CA Account
- Complete and Submit Applications
- Take & Send Official Test Scores (IF required)
- Transcript Requests (non Common App colleges)
- Submit FAFSA/CSS Profile (\*with family)
- Executing the last steps of LoR process
- Consistent Communication with CC @ DePaul
- Tell teachers if absent for college visit in advance

## **DePaul Prep Responsibilities**

- Letters of Rec (*writing*, *uploading*, *sending*)
- Sending Transcripts (already uploaded)
- School Profile (updates in progress)
- Counselor Forms/Reports
- Provide Post Secondary Guidance and Perspective
- Communication to Colleges



#### **Parent Responsibilities**

- Encourage Discernment & Value Seeking
- Encourage your Student to Self-Advocate
- Provide Perspective, but Give Space
- Assist with Tracker Completion
- Aid Student in FAFSA/CSS Completion
- Protect your Child's Privacy
- Celebrate Success
