# A PERSONALIZED EDUCATION

Parent/Guardian, Student, and MLA Administration meet to review the student transcript, school performance, and plans after high school.

Based on the reason for reassignment and the needs of the student, administration team, student, and guardian determines a plan of action to ensure the student successfully meets their goals.

# LIFE SKILLS 6 WEEK PROGRAM 2:30-4:30 TUES & THURS 6 WEEKS

- Students referred for a discipline issue are encouraged to complete the program prior to returning to their home school.
- High School students who lost course credit due to excessive absences but received a passing class can complete the program to receive course credit.
- Students who receive criminal charges may be required to complete the program based on probation requirements or school administration.

# Strengthening Families

Includes the entire family for one night a week for 10 weeks to workout issues.

- Students referred for a discipline issue are encouraged to complete the program prior to returning to their home school.

- Student struggling with issues in the school, community, or home.

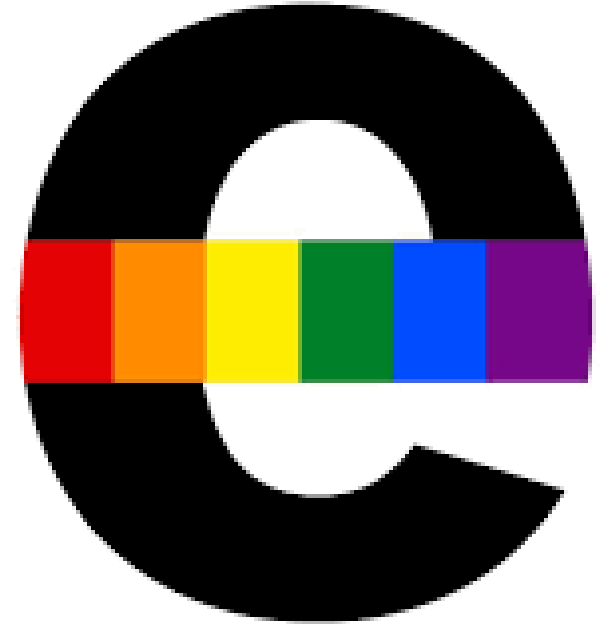


# Edmentum

---

Online platform to deliver curriculum at a student's pace and based on their prior knowledge with flexibility to complete when students work best.

- Students with extenuating circumstances which may cause them to miss an excessive amount of class time.
- Students who need to complete multiple credit recovery courses or full course to be on track to graduate with their cohort group.
- Students who need extra support or practice in a specific class.
- Students who need an adjusted schedule.



# RESTORATIVE JUSTICE & SOCIAL CIRCLES DR. POWELL



- Students referred for substance abuse issues (drugs, vaping, alcohol) meet one on one and with a social circle to discuss their choices and how it impacted them and the people around them.
- Students referred for discipline issues meet with one on one and then with others involved to work through resolutions.

# SCHOOL STORE

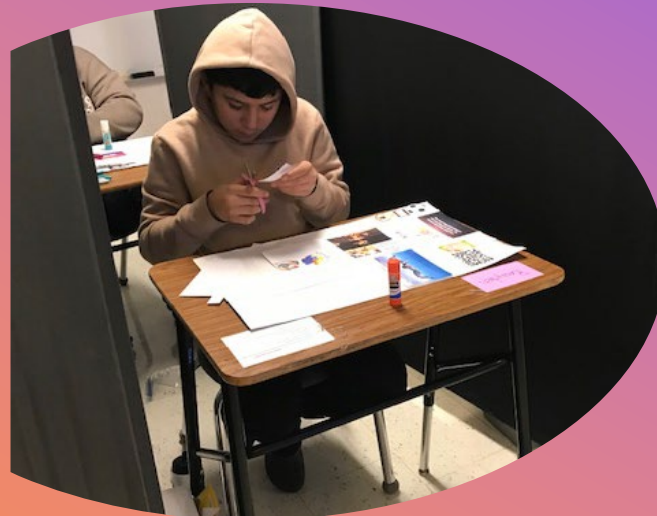
STUDENTS STRUGGLING IN THE CLASSROOM WITH BEHAVIOR

- Student, guardian, teacher, and administrative team create behavior goals based on issues the student is experiencing in the school environment.
- Students earn points for desired behaviors.
- On Friday, the student can cash in points for items in the school store.
- School store is supported by donations and grants.



# SOCIAL SKILLS TRAINING

All Middle School students are required to complete daily social skills training.



# CTE Training for High School Students

- Once students are on track, they can participate in CTE courses at the CTE Building.
- Students are transported as needed.
