PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

Instruction and Supervision

- 1. Learn and adhere to the coaching philosophy and program of the head coach.
- 2. Assist in explaining and distributing literature to all athletes concerning the Athletic Code of Conduct, team expectations and the protecting of student eligibility (MSHSAA).
- 3. Teach athletes the fundamental skills, theory and strategy of the sport.
- 4. Teach the athletes the value of good conduct, sportsmanship and good citizenship.
- 5. Provide supervision of athletes at all times and apply discipline in a firm productive manner.
- 6. Teach and emphasize safe procedures to the athletes.
- 7. Assist the head coach with out-of-season training as needed. Encourage multiple sport athletic participation.
- 8. Attend and assist with the athletic awards program.

Equipment and Facilities

- 9. Assist in the responsibility for care of equipment and facilities being used.
- 10. Assist in the issuance, return and maintenance of equipment.
- 11. Assist in insuring that all equipment is cleaned, repaired and stored properly at the end of the season.
- 12. Make recommendations to the head coach concerning needed equipment or repairs to facilities.

Administrative Duties

- 13. Enforce all building and district regulations and policies.
- 14. Assist head coach in registering and maintaining records on all athletes.
- 15. Assist head coach in assuring that a copy of the student's physical is current and in your possession before allowing them to participate.
- 16. Assist the head coach in assuring that a copy of the student's code of conduct and team expectations is current and in your possession before allowing them to compete.
- 17. Assist in providing information on game times, bus schedules, and practice times to parents and athletes.
- 18. Conduct yourself as a personal example of positive demeanor for the athletes and represent the school in a favorable manner.
- 19. Work cooperatively with the head coach on all endeavors related to your sport.
- 20. Perform scouting duties, bus travel duties, video/film work and study for the assigned team per the head coach's request.

Education

- 21. Have knowledge and keep current on rules and regulations regarding your sport in accordance with MSHSAA.
- 22. Keep abreast of new knowledge and innovative ideas and techniques by attending clinics, workshops, or other methods.
- 23. Maintain certification in CPR and First Aid.
- 24. Attend MSHSAA rules meetings and inform assistants of changes in rules.
