Grant Application Process

Frequently asked questions

What is it?

The Golf4Grants Endowment Fund is a nonprofit organization affiliated with the Middlesboro Education Foundation that enables new and innovative approaches to learning that are not supported through the traditional funding of public education.

What will it do?

Money raised in the fund will be used to support new and innovative approaches to learning in the classroom. From this fund grants will be provided to local educators to enhance learning and support our schools. Local educators may apply for grants to enhance the learning opportunities for students.

Who can apply?

Educators and counselors employed by Middlesboro Schools

How do I apply?

Complete the grant application that will be available on the Middlesboro Schools website.

How do I submit the grant application?

Submissions will be accepted through the mail or hand delivered to the central office.

Faxed applications will NOT be accepted.

When are the applications due?

Applications must be submitted to Sherri Hoskins at the Central Office no later than May 1st of each year.

When will the award winners be notified?

Winners will be announced in May. Funding will be for the following academic year.

I applied last year may I apply again?

Yes, the grant-review committee's charge is to work with individual applicants to make the best project possible.

What if I was awarded a grant, can I apply the following year?

The committee has instituted a 3-year rule for repeating applications. The only exception to this rule will be if the committee funds your projects in stages. We would encourage and invite you to assist your

peers with grant applications in the interim. The committee's job is to say "yes" to grants, but also to spread it around, thanks for your understanding.

I've never applied before is there anything thing I should be aware of?

Yes, review these action items:

- Does the project provide significant, ongoing benefits to a large number of students?
- Contain clearly defined goals and objectives?
- Help to satisfy unmet needs and can be easily replicated?
- Include an effective implementation plan and evaluation plan?
- Offer creative/innovative learning experiences for the student?
- Tips when completing your application
- Concise writing is appreciated and encouraged
- Correct spelling and grammar are a must
- Please do not use acronyms unless they are explained in the narrative (non-school personnel will be evaluating these grant applications and might not be familiar with current lingo)
- Include the description/names of the items you are requesting (part/model numbers are insufficient)
- Indicate if the items requested are mandatory for implementing your grant project. Maximum amount awarded per grant is \$1000.00
