The Common App simplifies the college admission process by saving time and eliminating duplication of effort. Once completed, copies of the application for Undergraduate Admission and second school forms may be sent to any of the participating colleges or universities.



Criteria – Senior with proven academic performance and financial need – both carry equal weight.

Proof of financial need is a requirement (include a copy of parent's W-2 + 1st page of IRS Form 1040).

Complete and submit to guidance counselor or mail before September 20th, 2024.

All Quest programs require that applicants fill out and submit an online application. Uniquely designed and administered by QuestBridge, the application highlights each student's outstanding strengths and achievements, and turn low-income challenges into advantages for the college admissions process.

Applications are available online and are due by September 26, 2024.
